In a shell, you can type commands to perform various tasks, such as running programs, modifying files, and interacting with the operating system. The shell reads the commands you type and runs them for you.





Follow the steps below to SH in shell settings.


1: Once logged in, look for a "Server" and click on it.




2. Scroll down and Select the Site Option.




3. Selected site.




4. Scroll down and select the Site Shell Settings Option.
