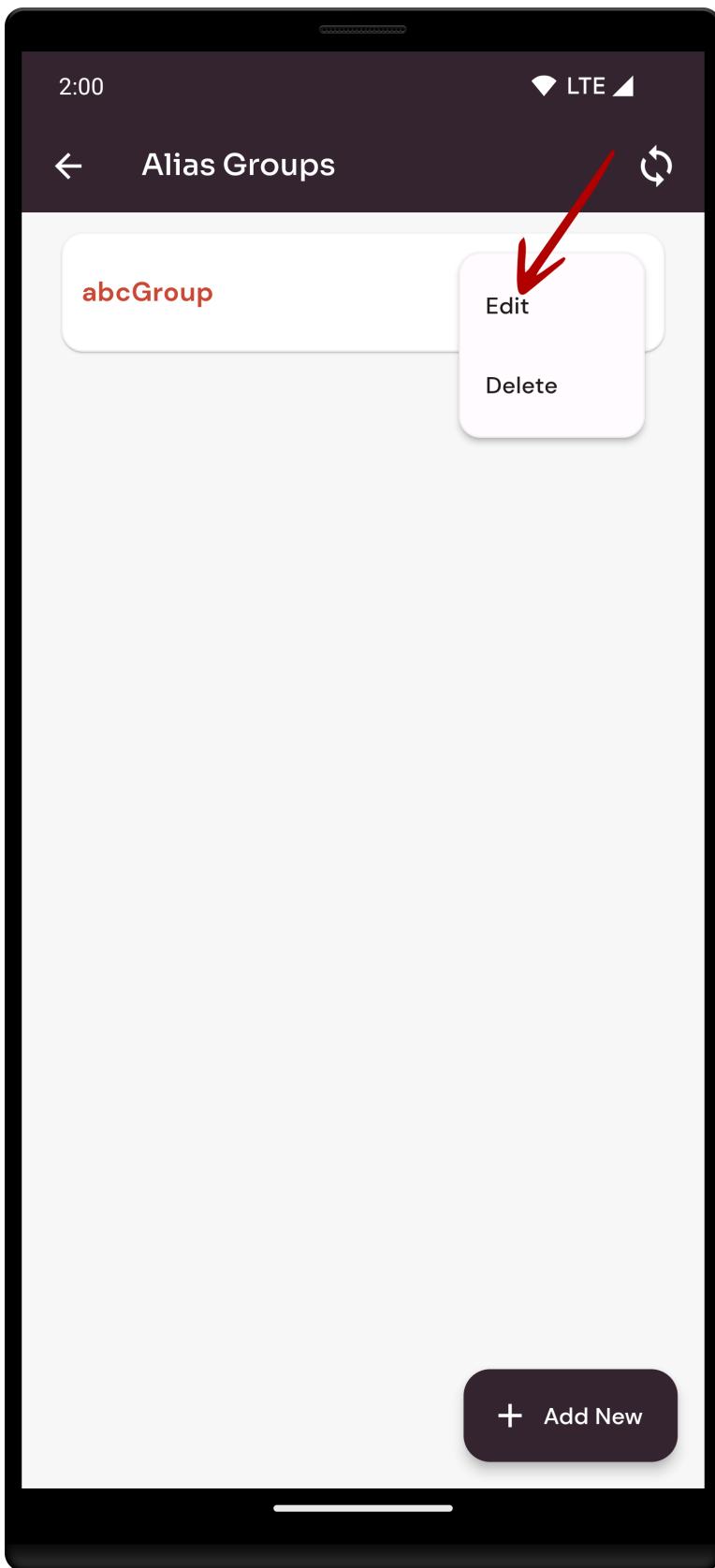




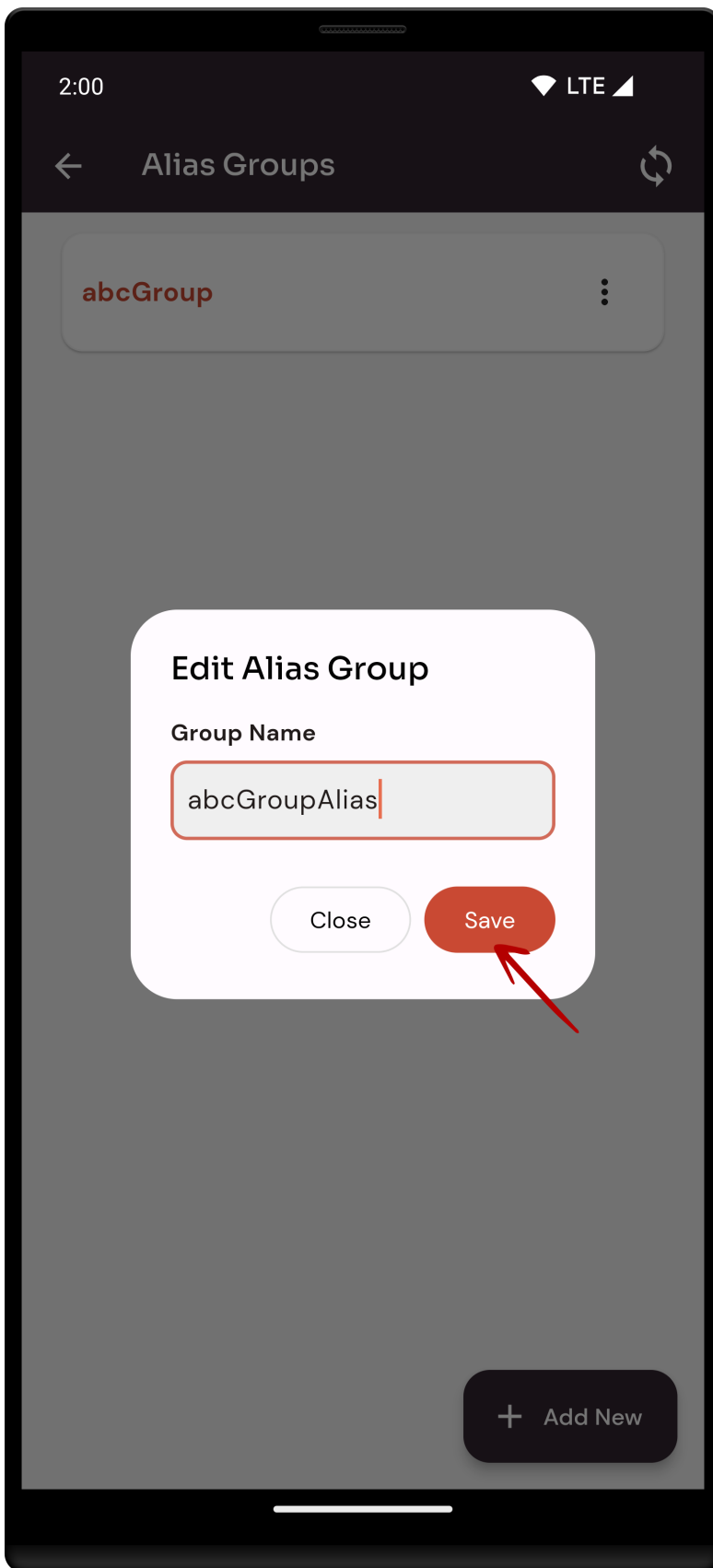
2: Select the Shell Alias option.



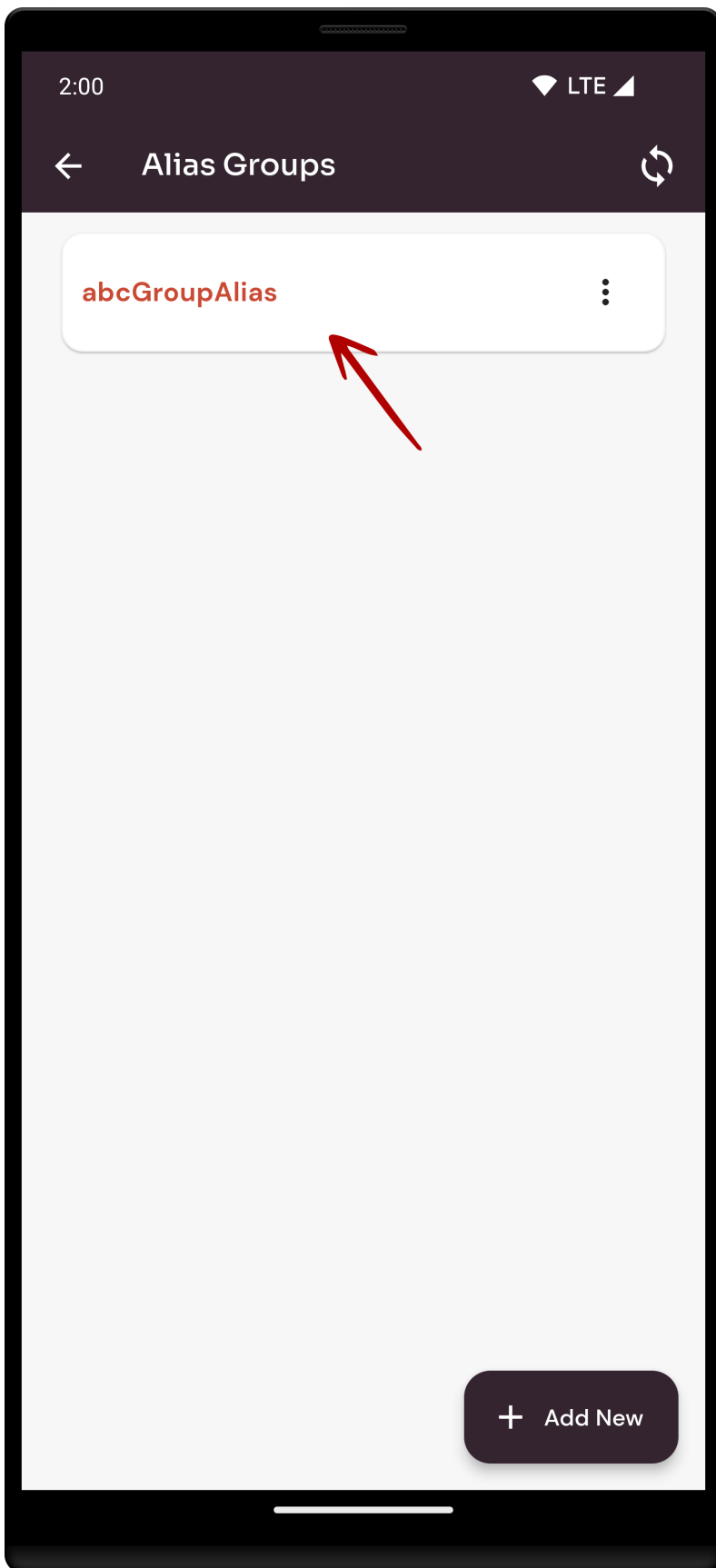
3. Click on the menu icon and select Edit Option.
