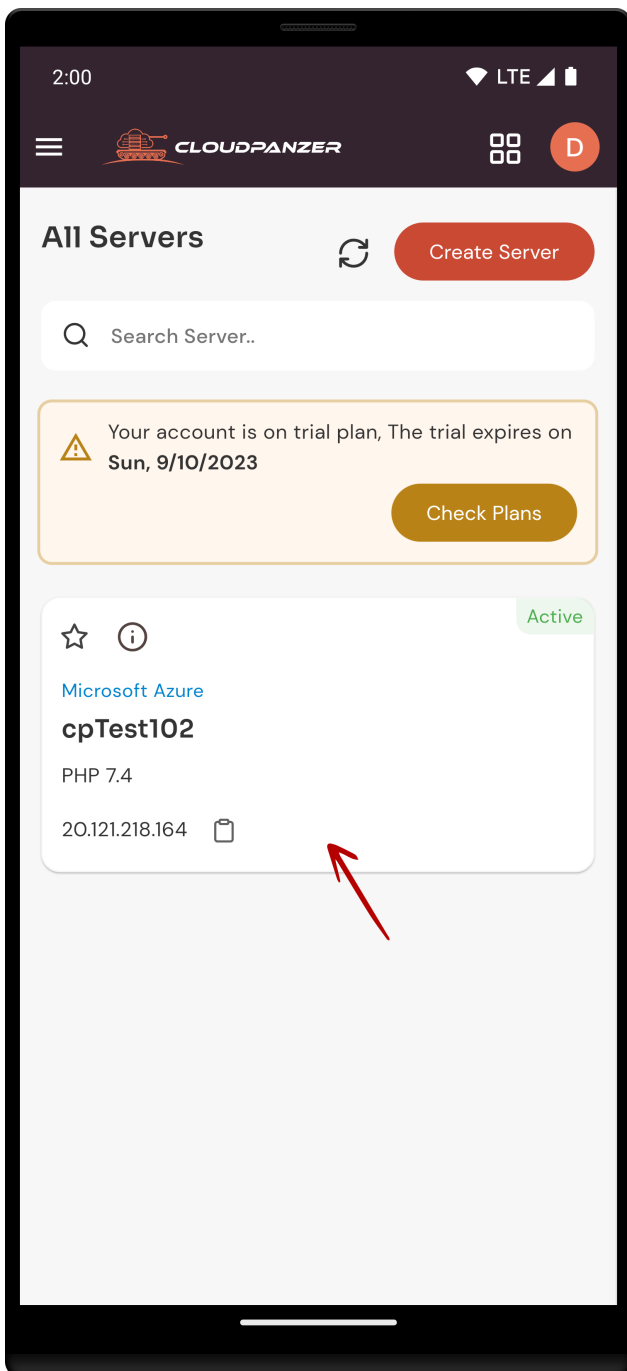

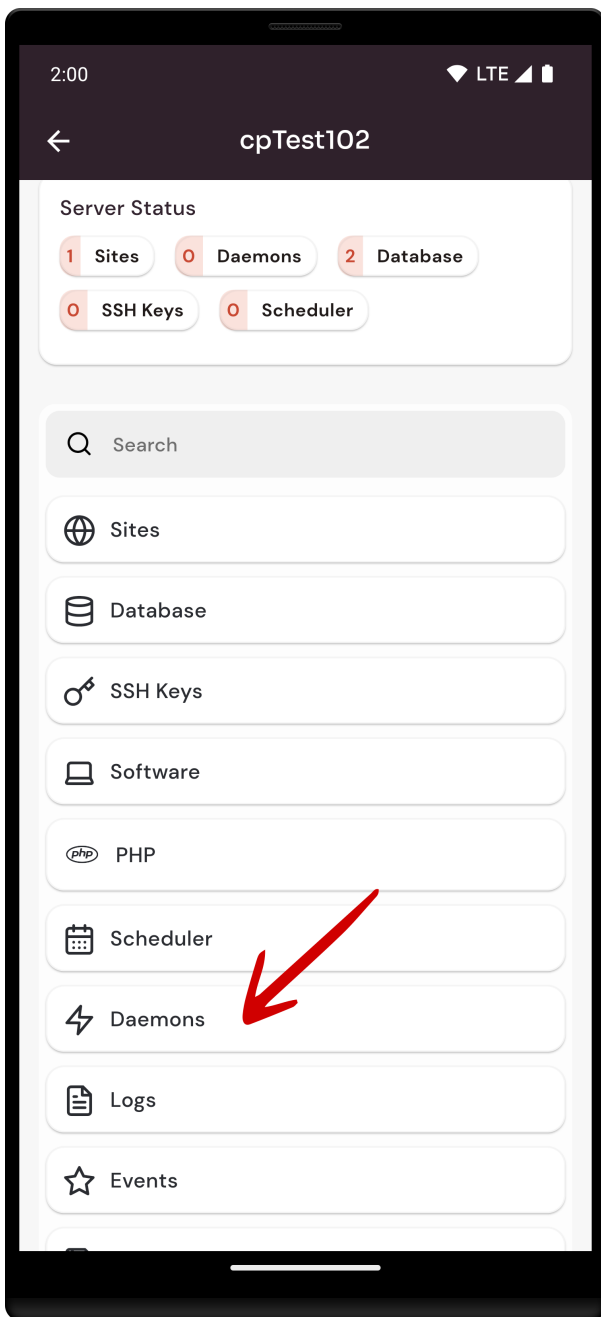

Follow the steps below to Edit supervisor conf in Daemons.

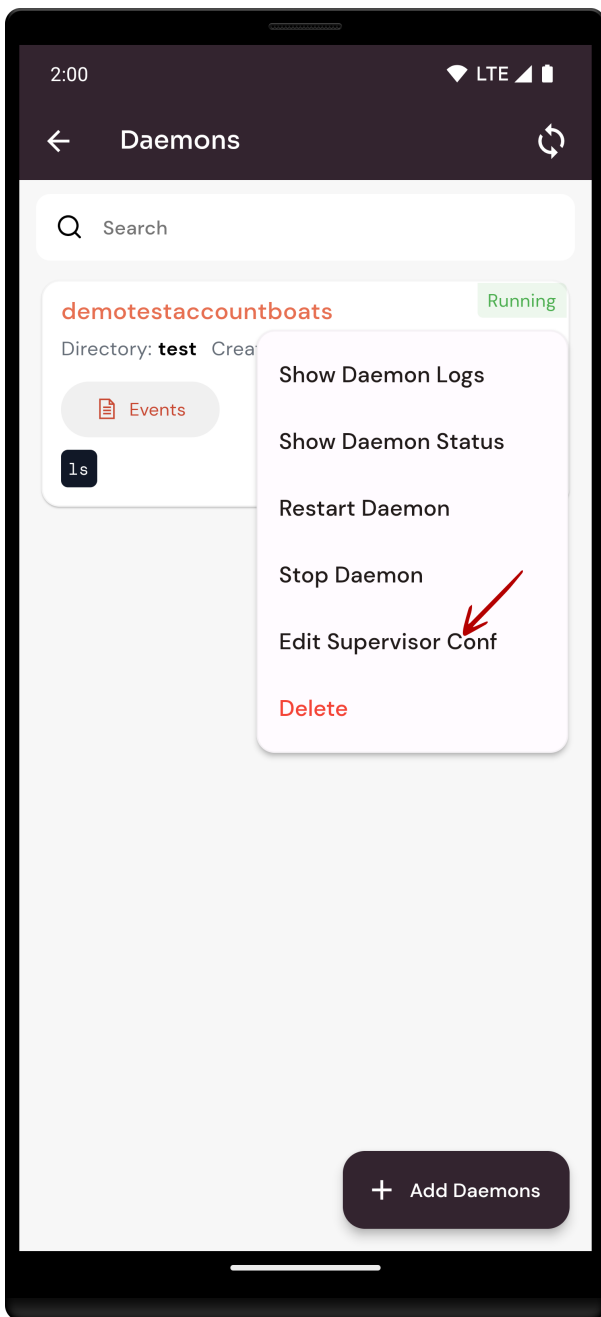
1: Once logged in, look for a "Server" and click on it.



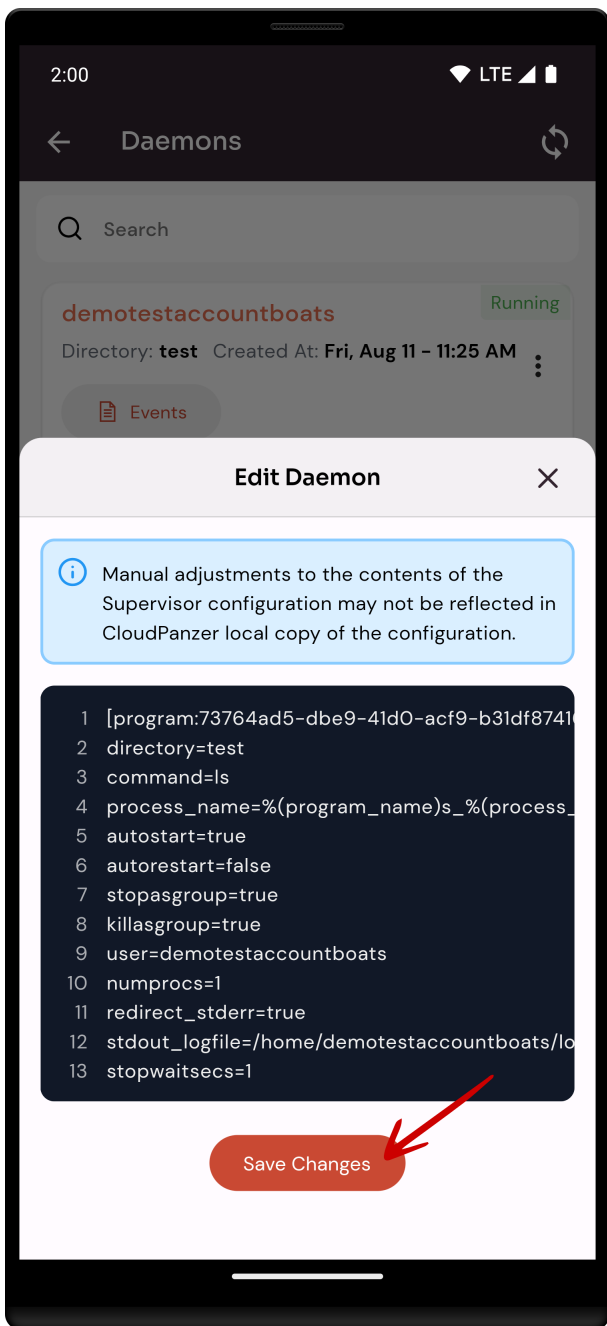
2. Click on the daemons button.



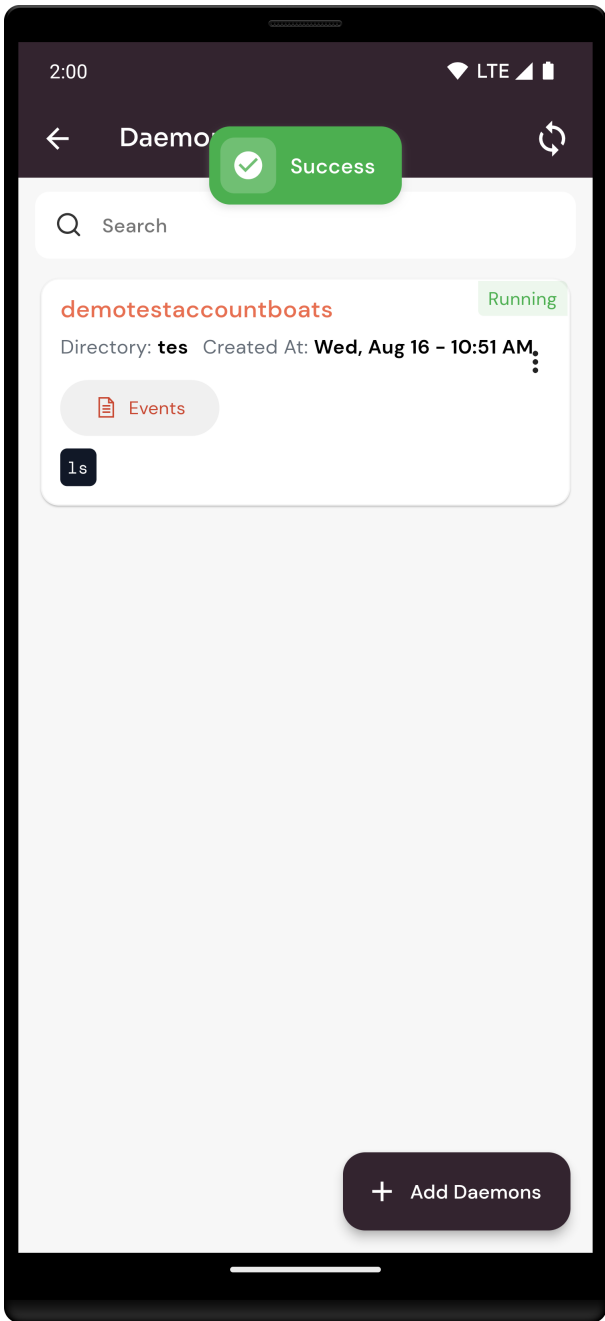
3. Click on the menu icon and Select Edit Supervisor Conf Option.
