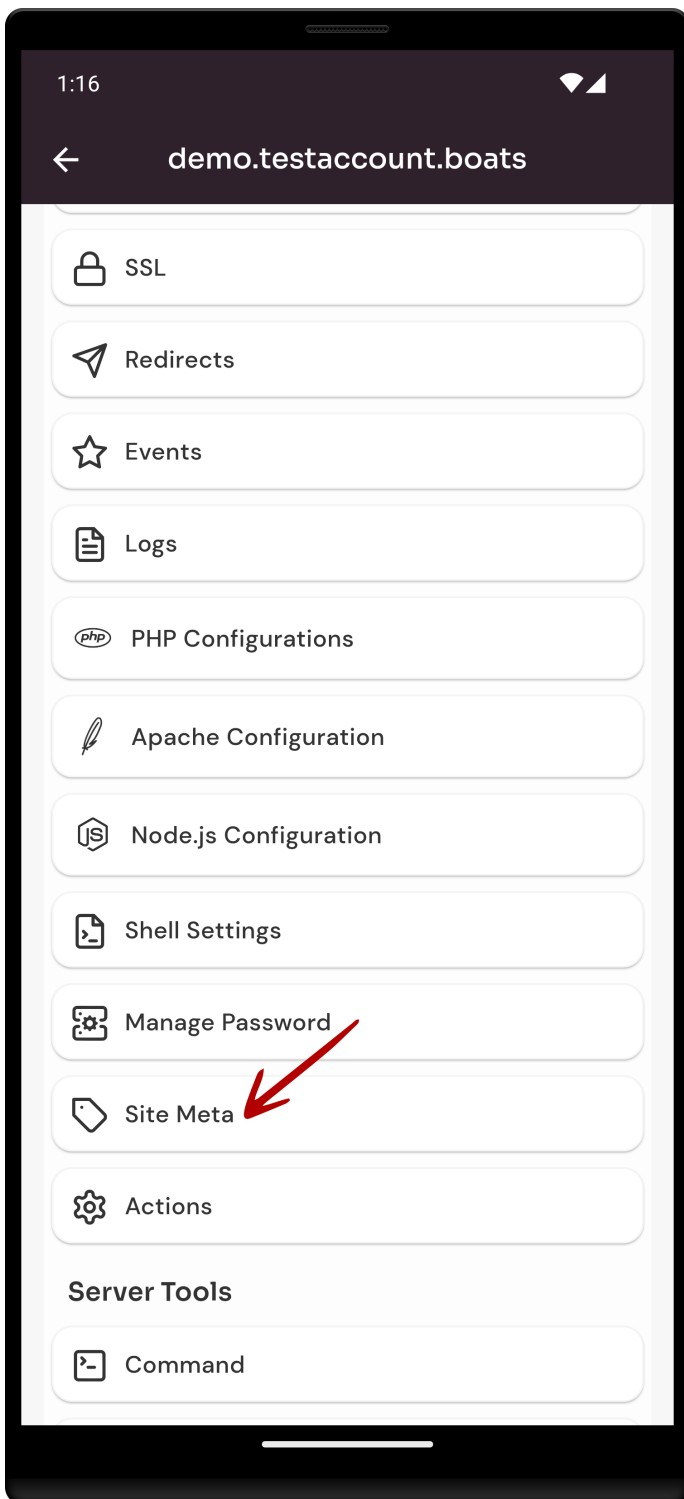

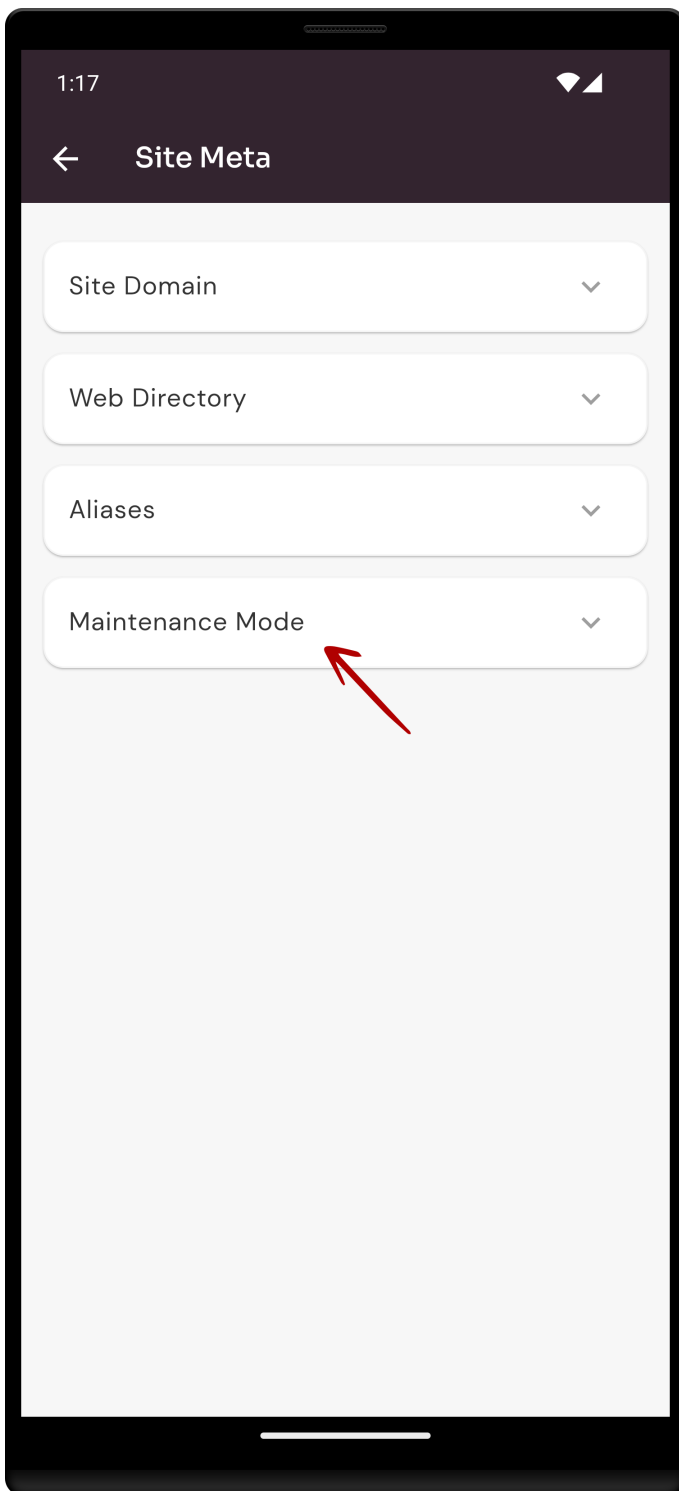
Follow the steps below to enable/ disable maintenance mode on site.

**Navigate to the site Dashboard (**[\*\*Use this link to view How to Navigate\*\*](#)**)**

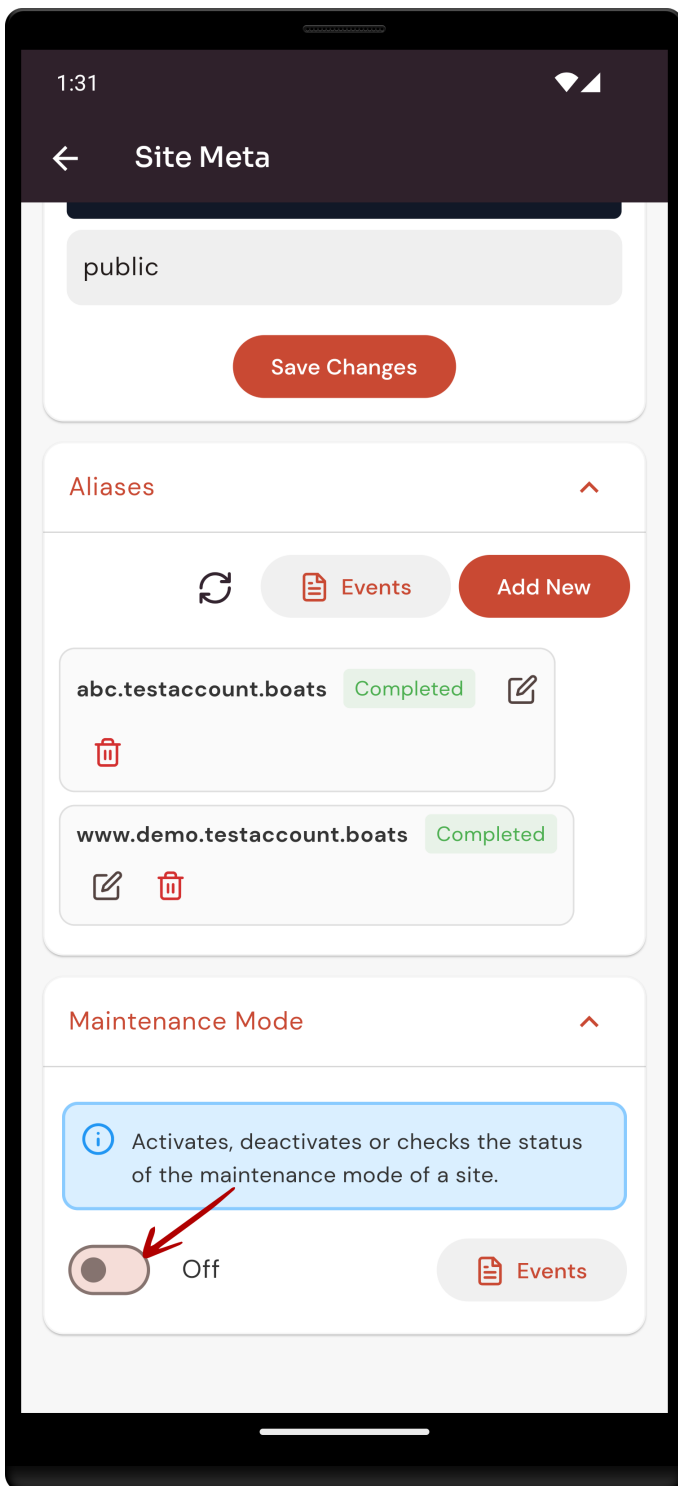
1. Select the Site Meta Option.
