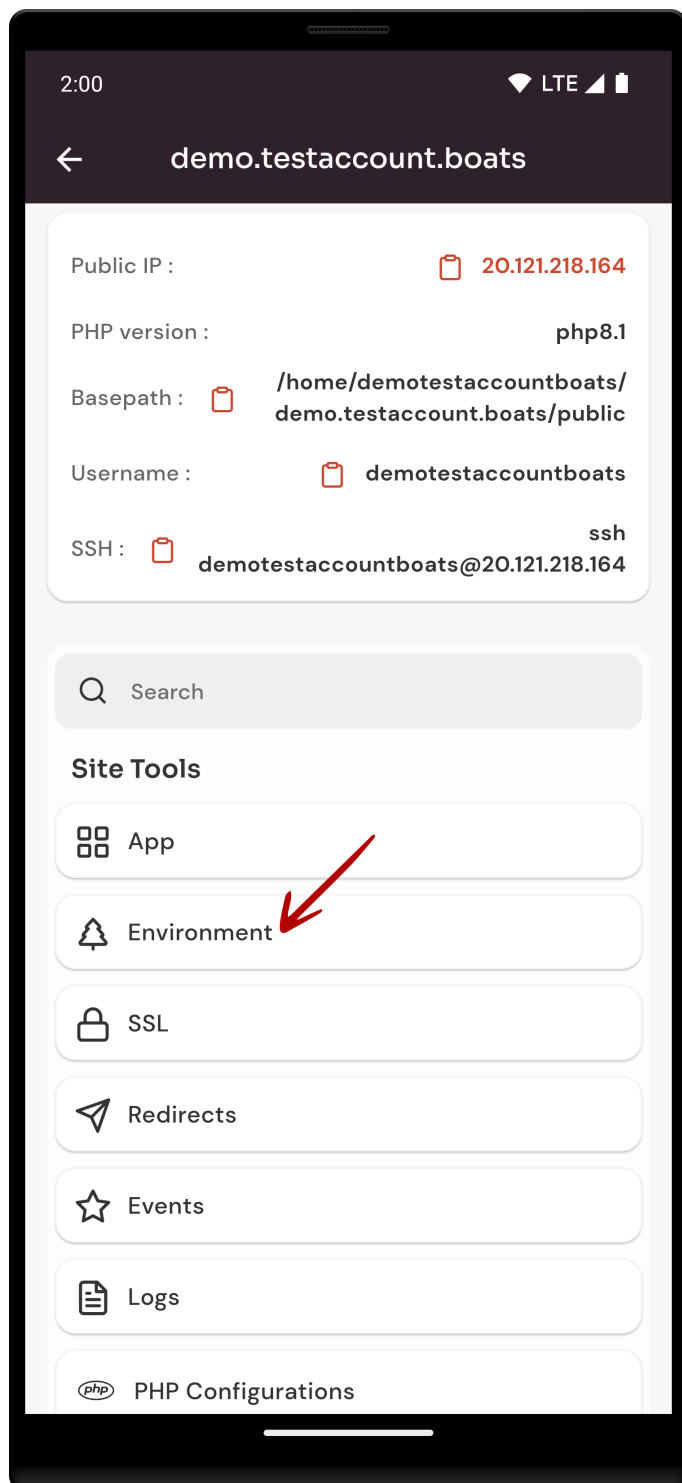

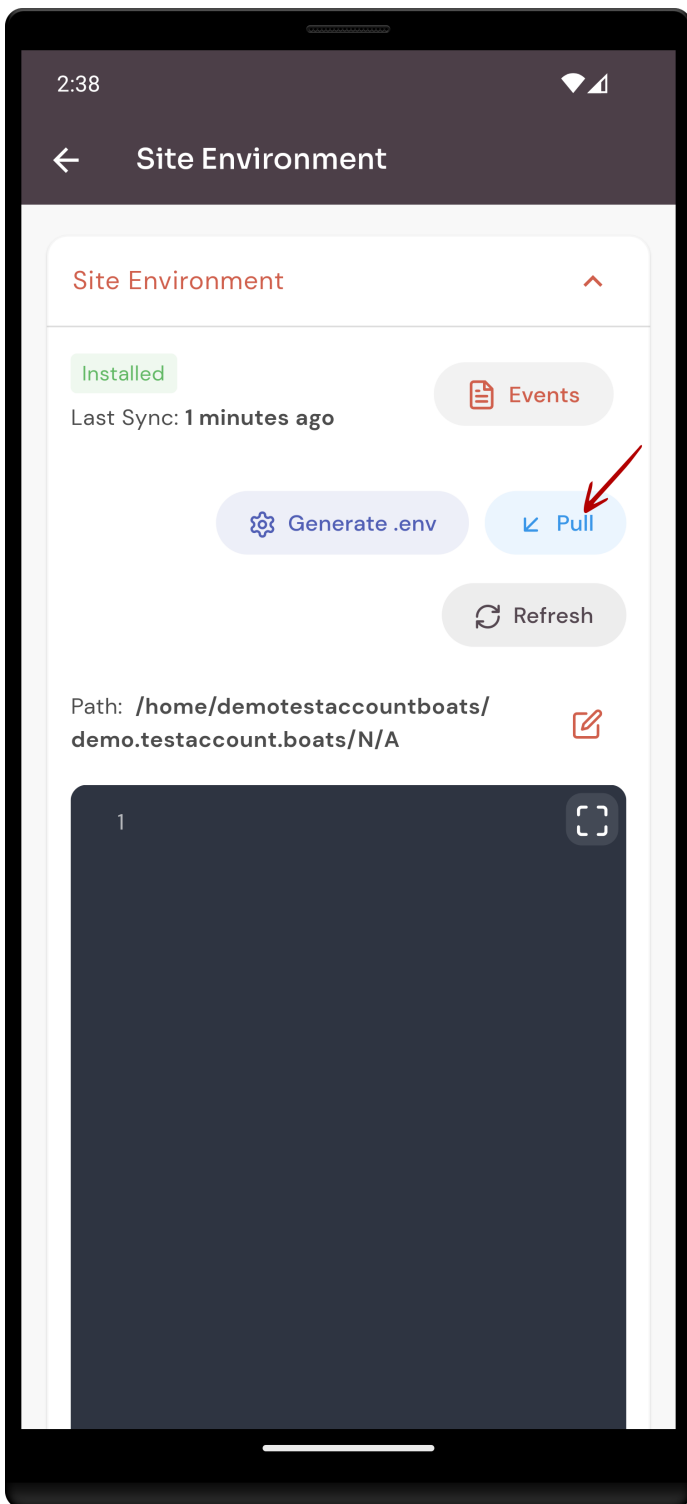
Navigate to the site Dashboard ([Use this link to view How to Navigate](#))

4. Select the Environment Option.



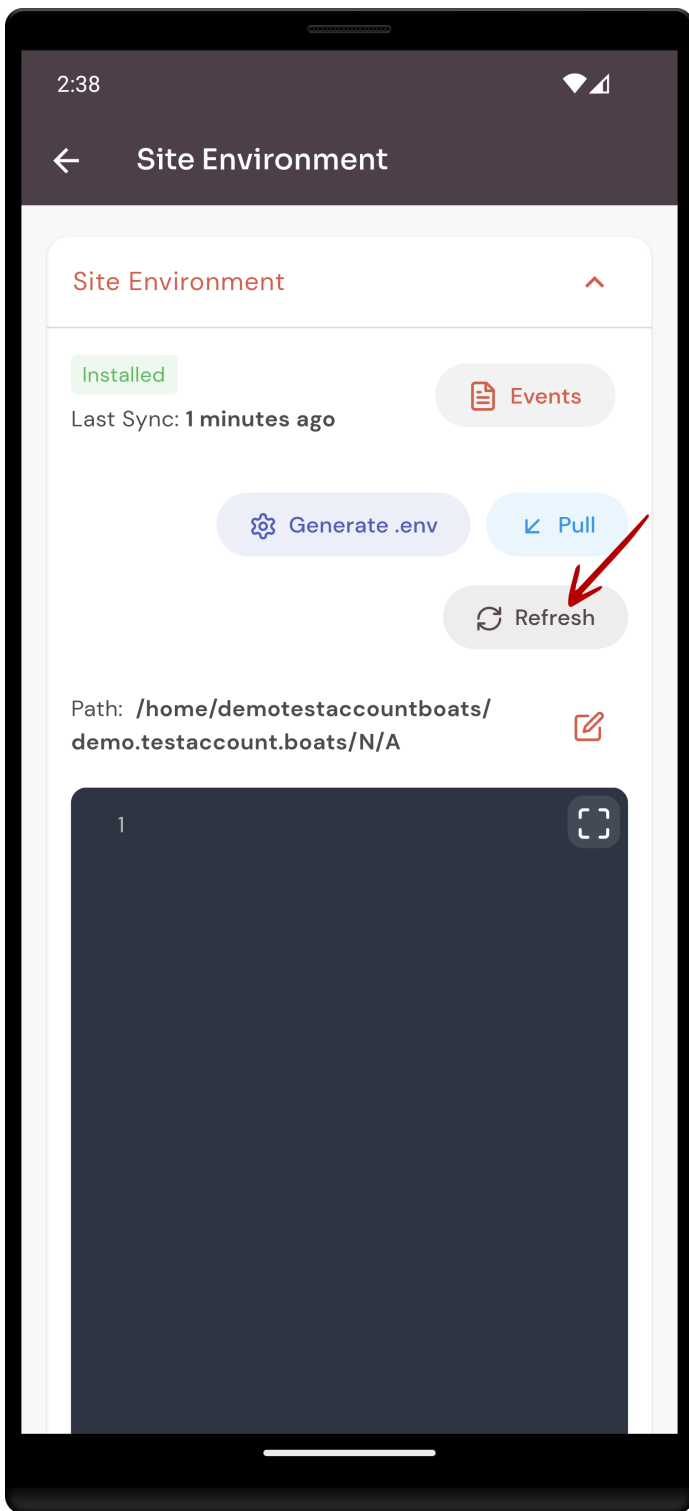
Pull :

Click on the pull button.



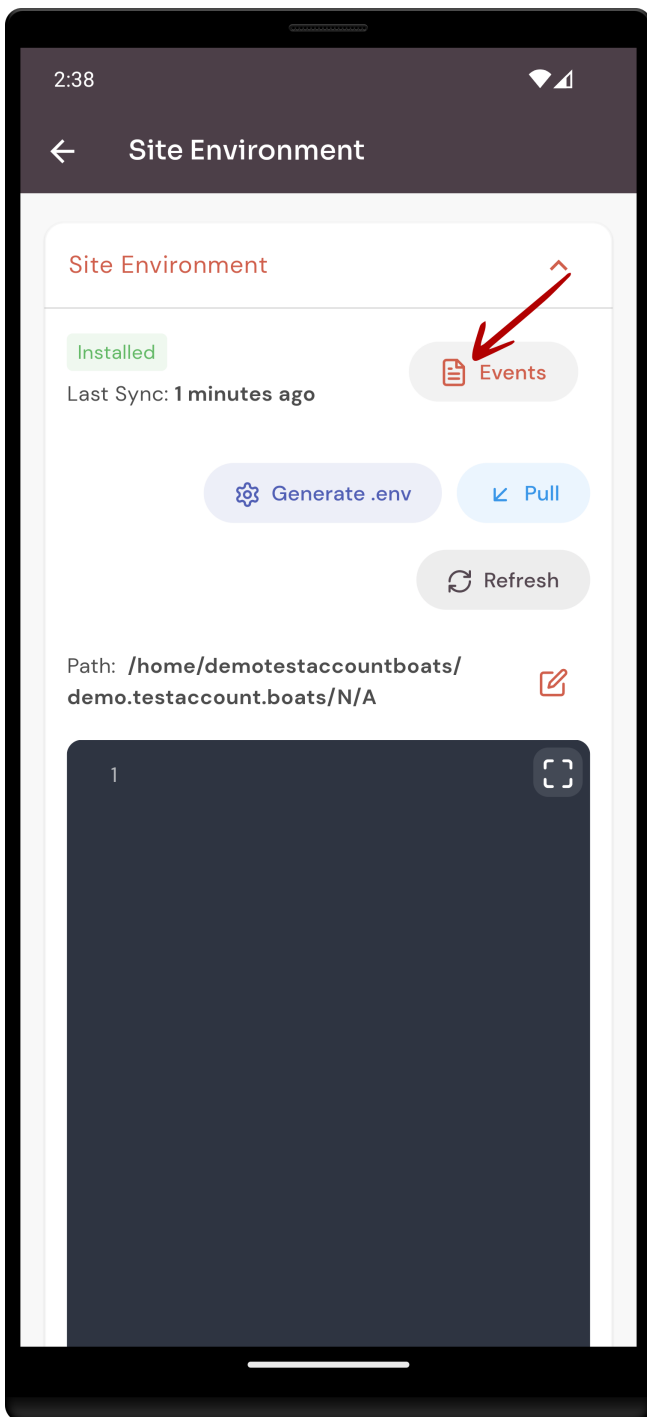
Refresh :
