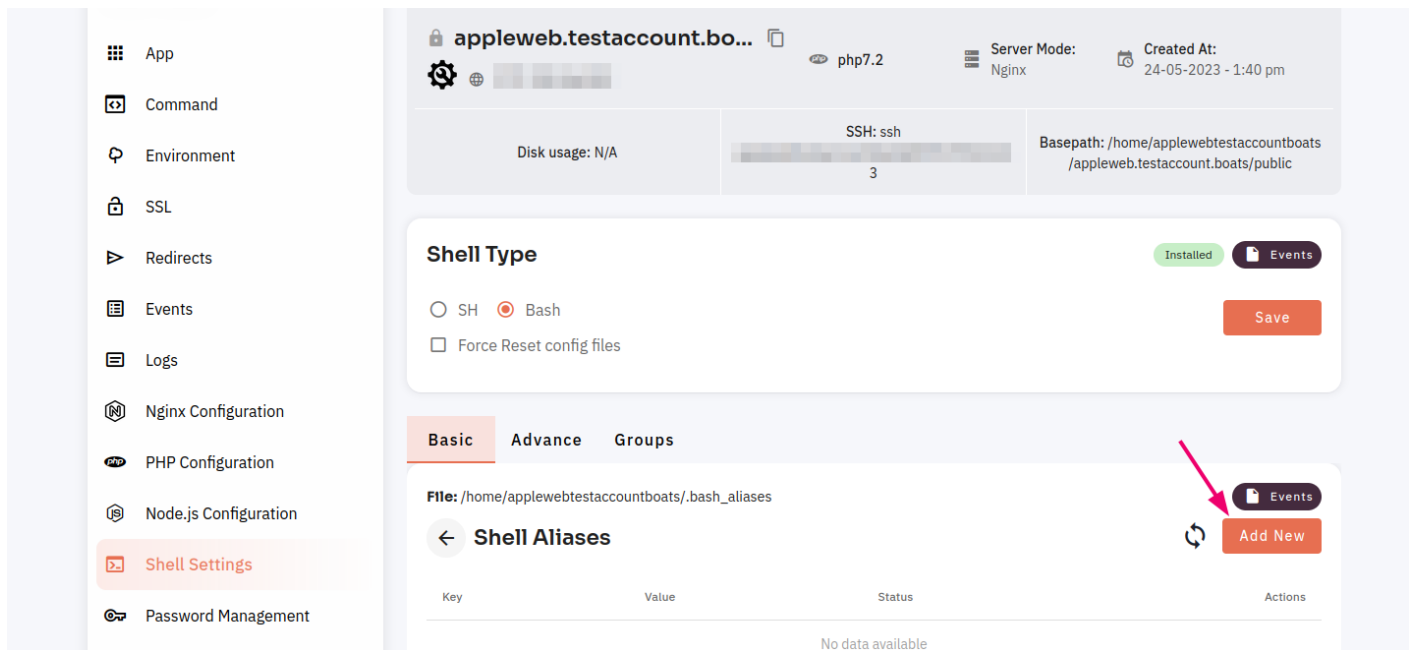

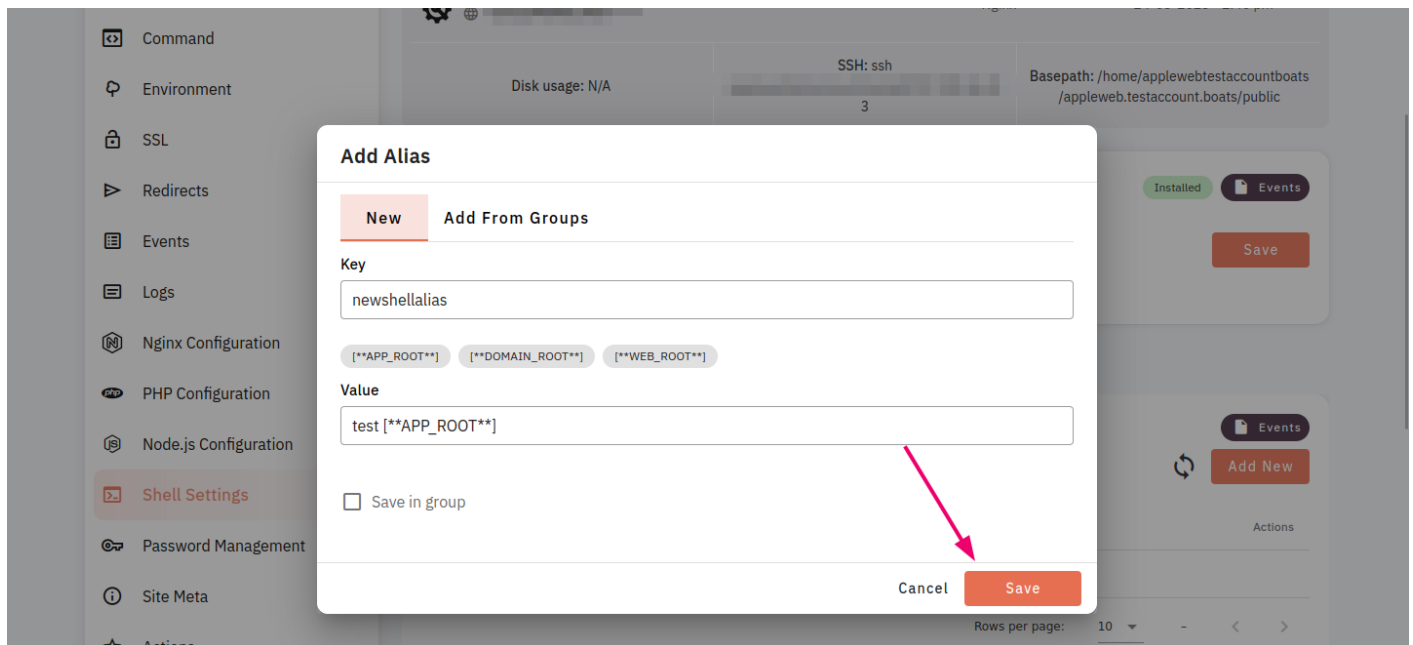

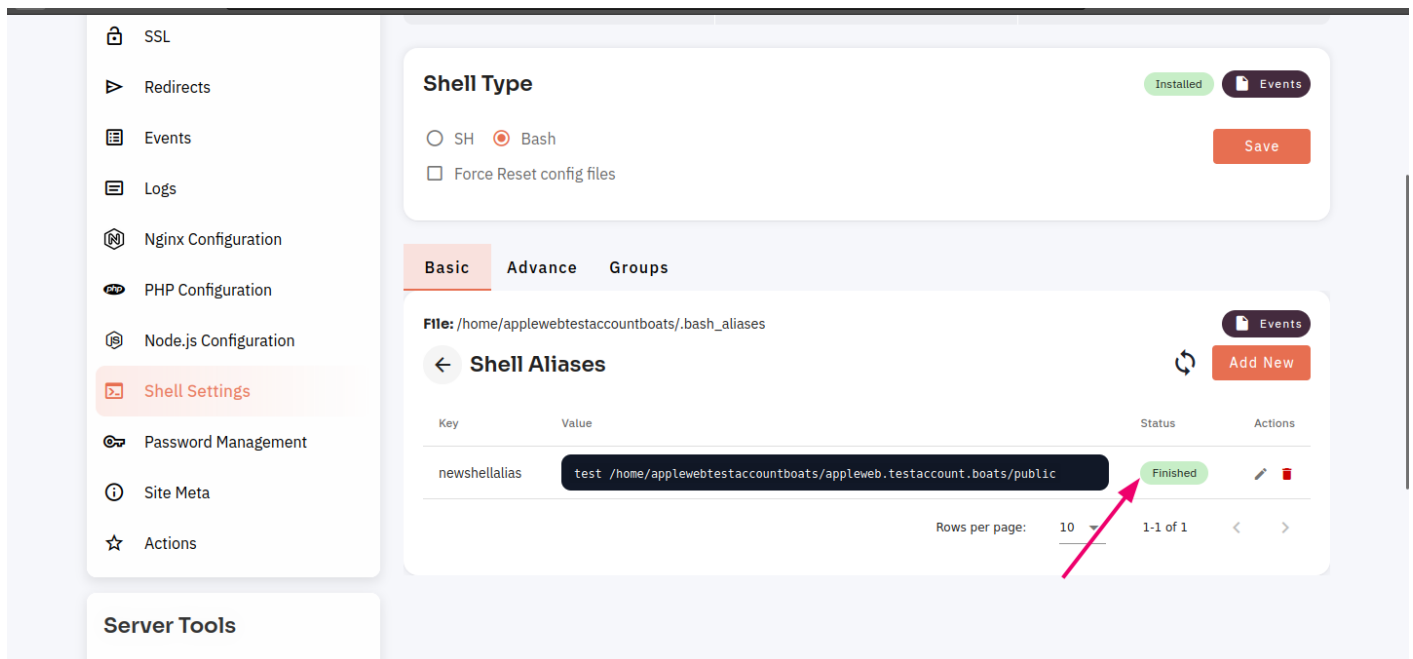
4: Click on Add new button.
