## Navigate to the Node js

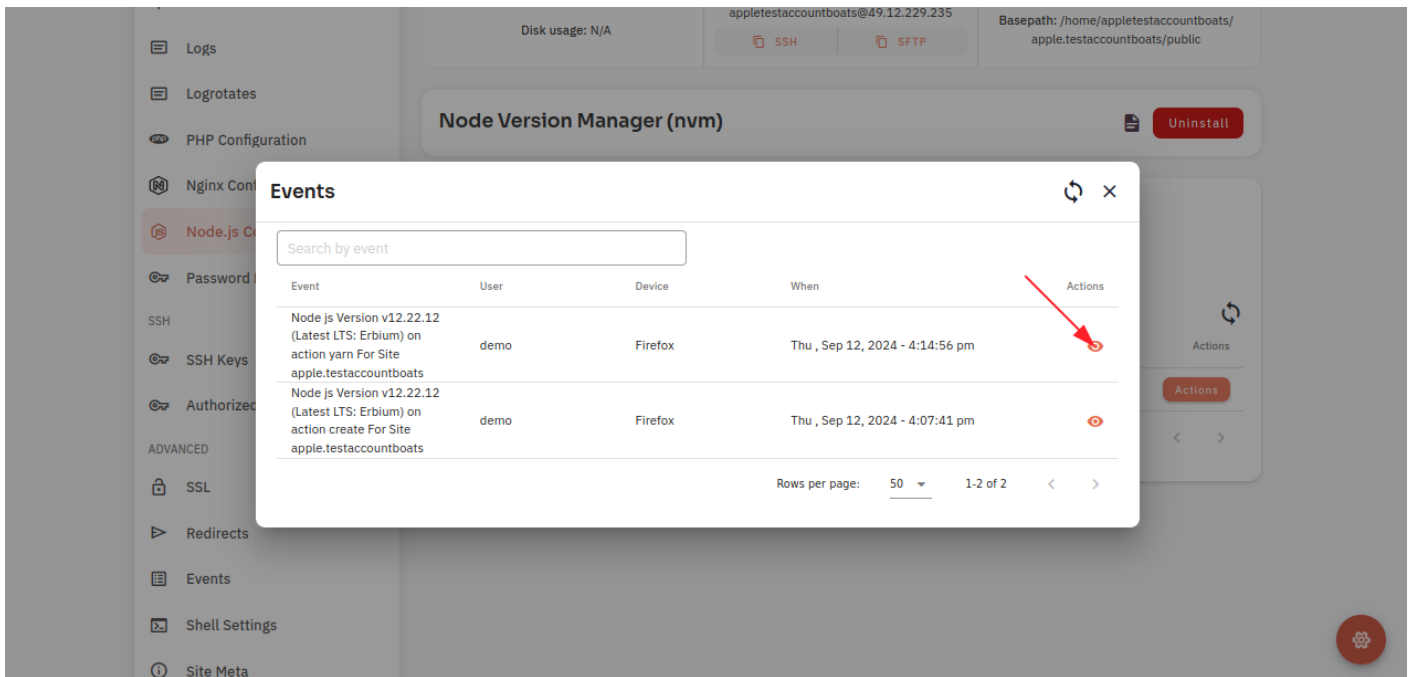

### 3. Select an Event Option

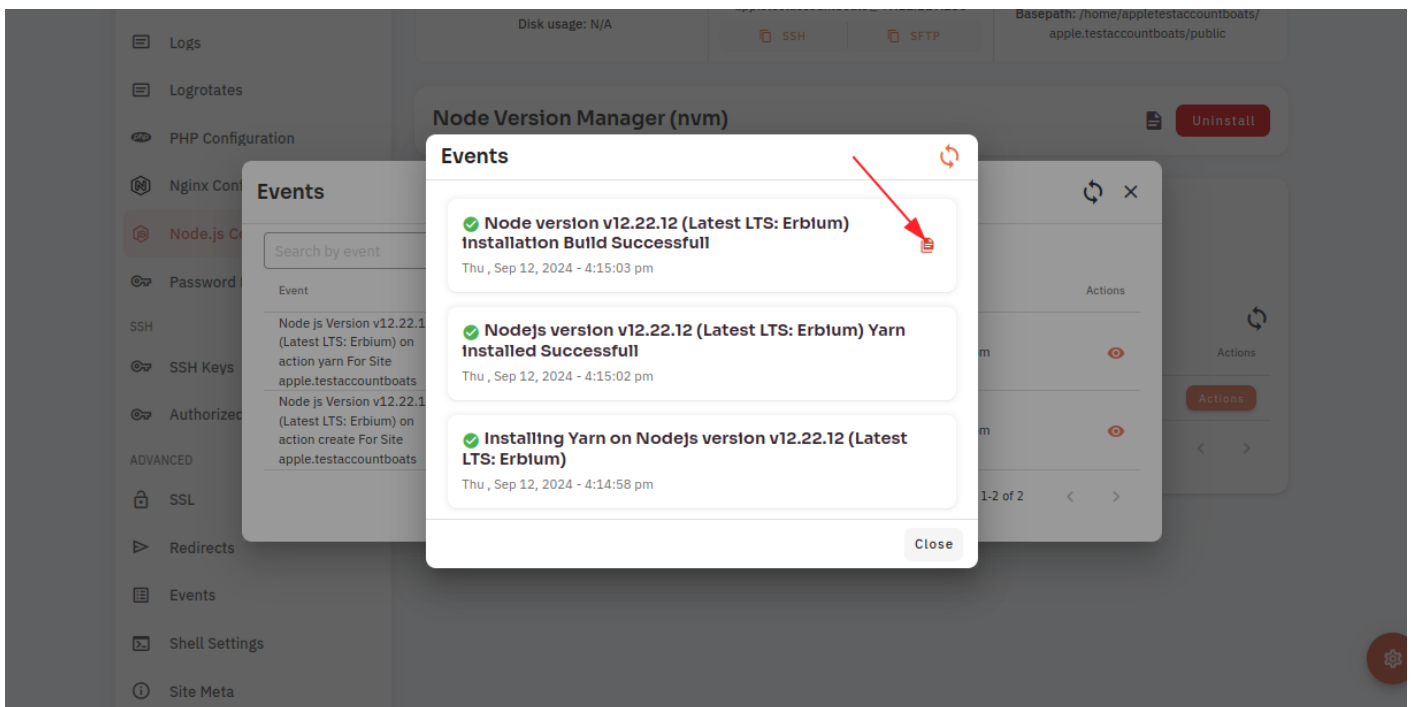

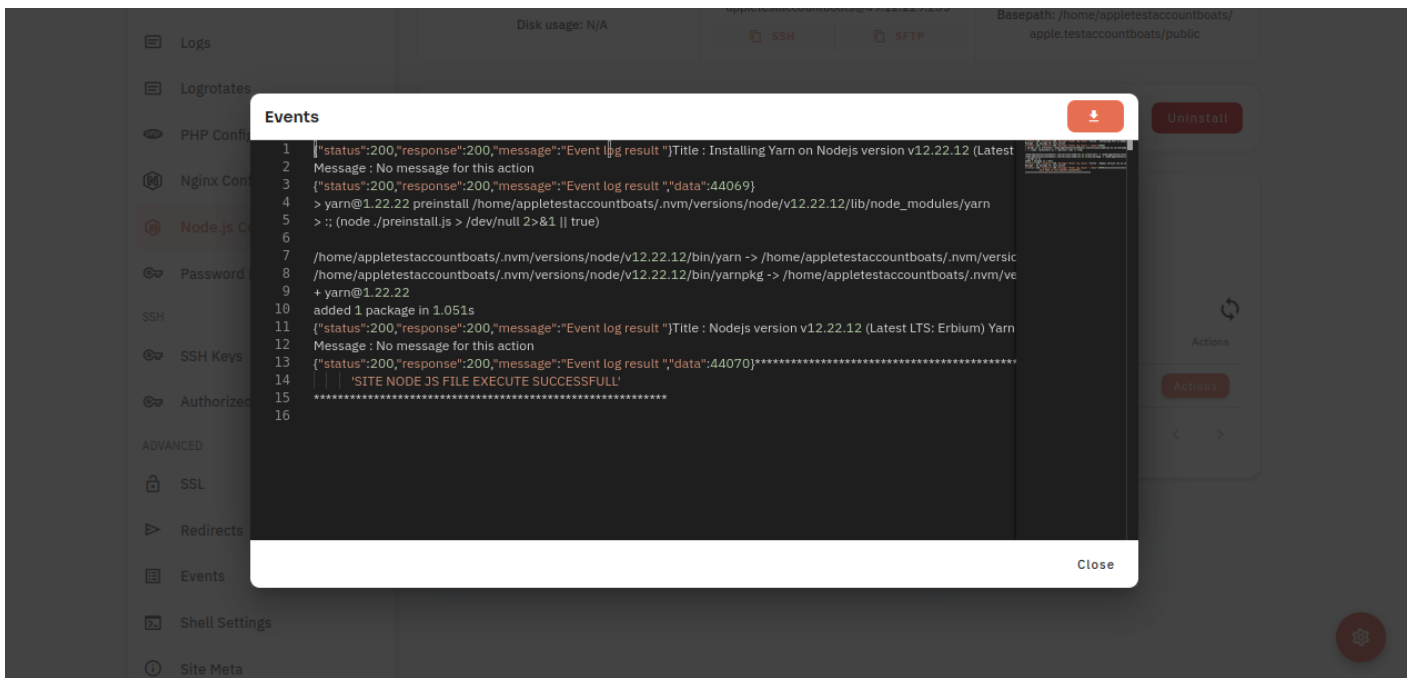
