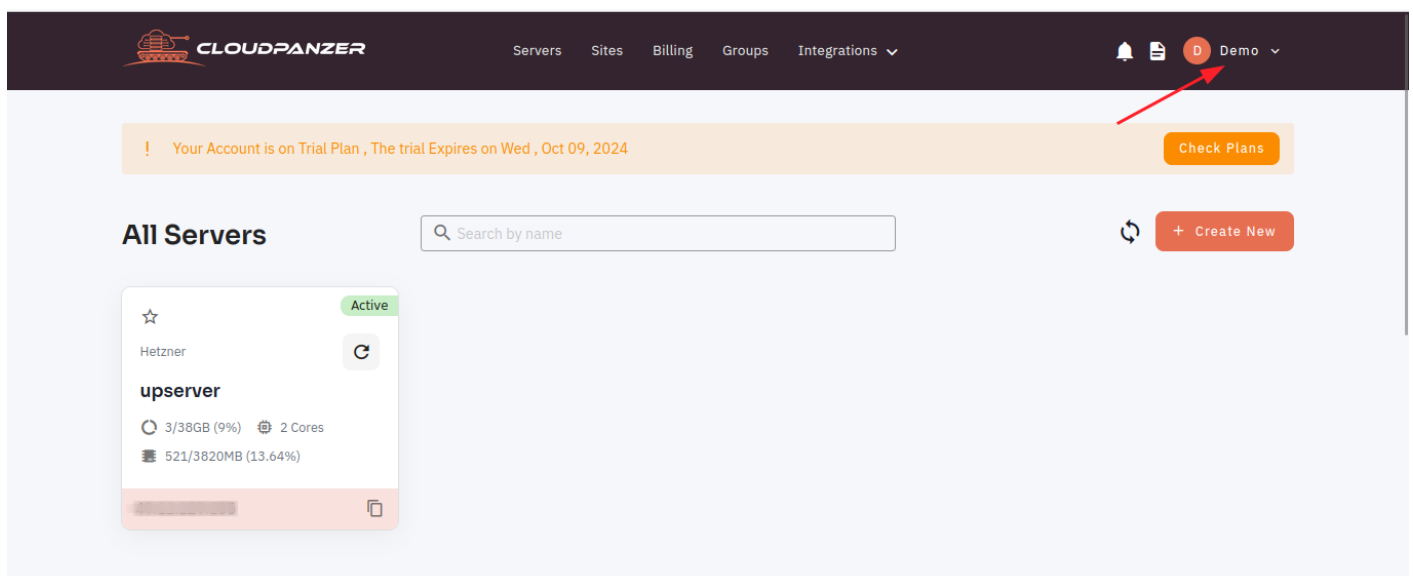

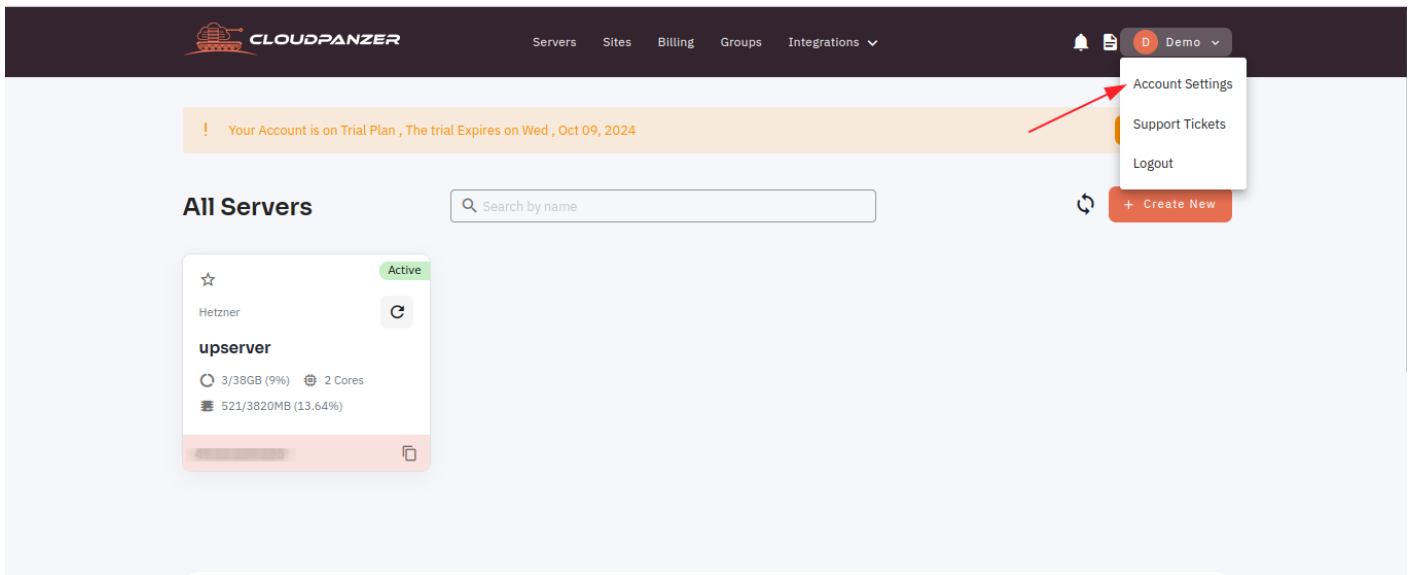

Follow the steps below to edit Shell Aliases Group

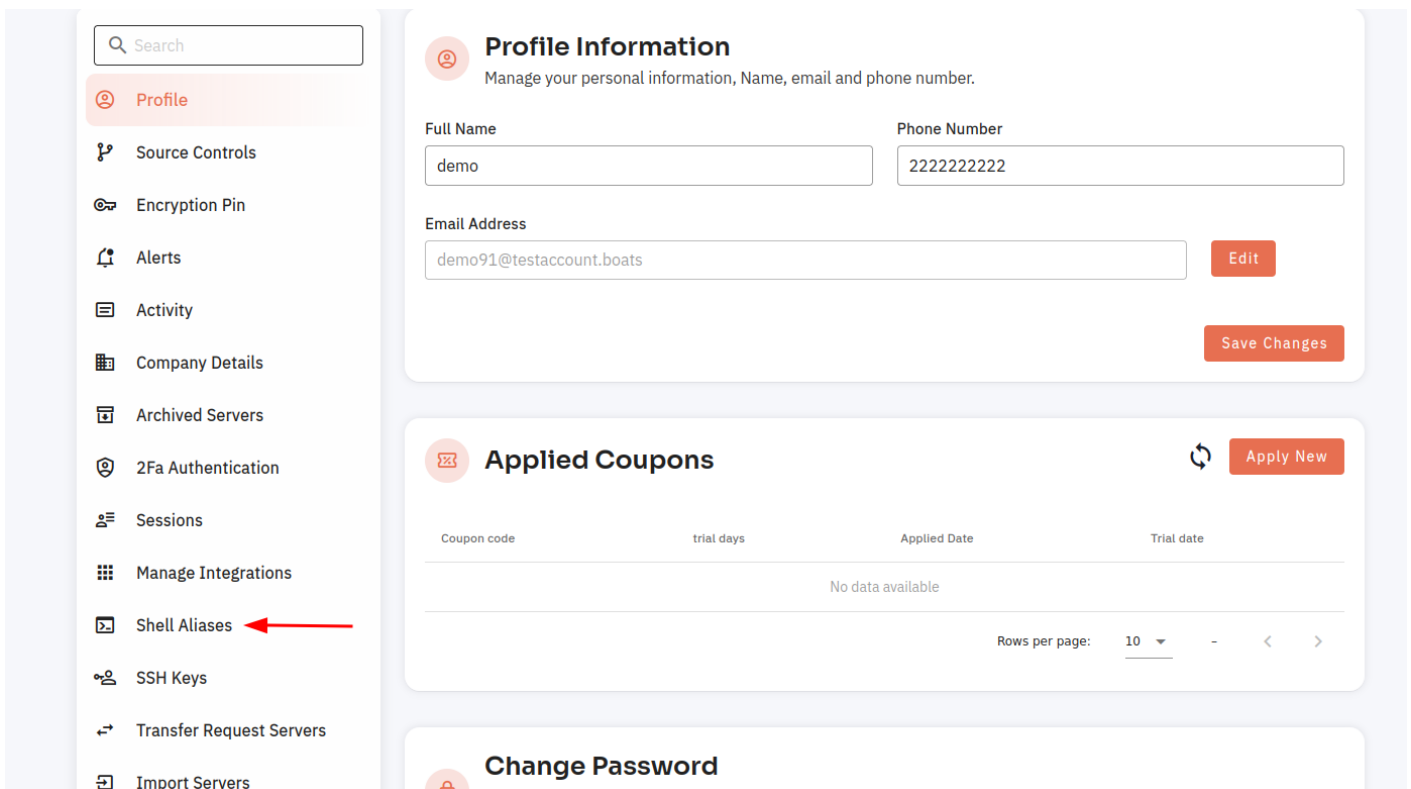
1. Click on the User Profile.



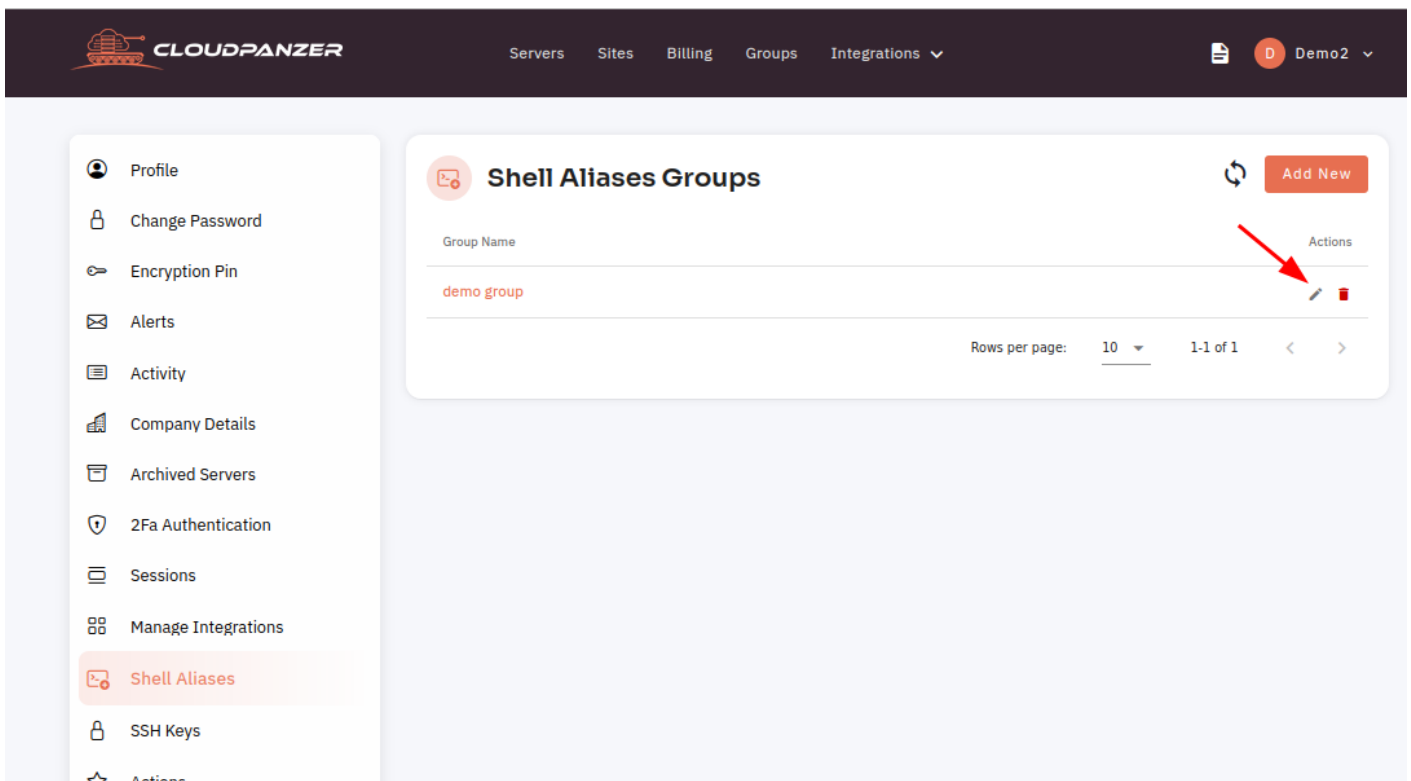
2. Go to Account Settings.



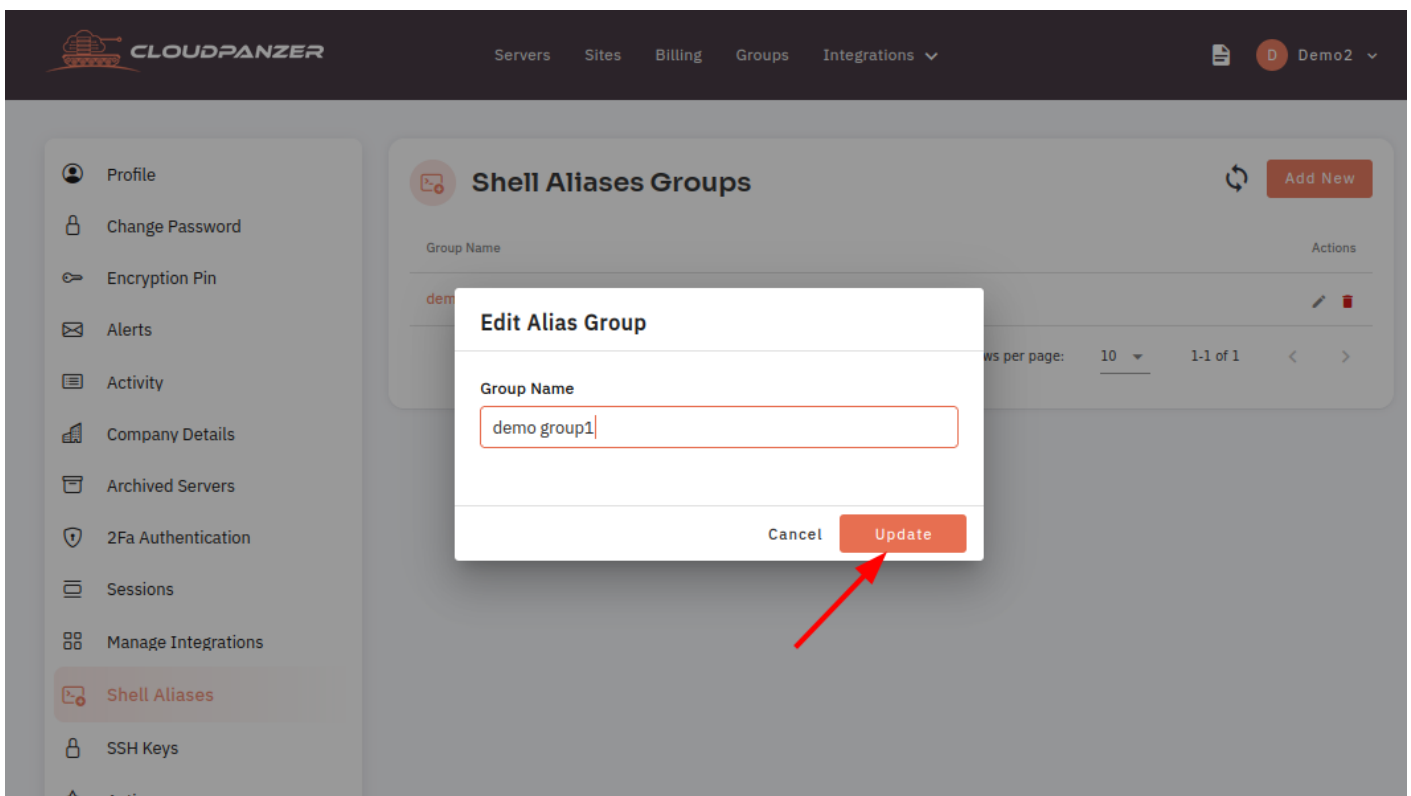
3. Click on Shell Aliases.



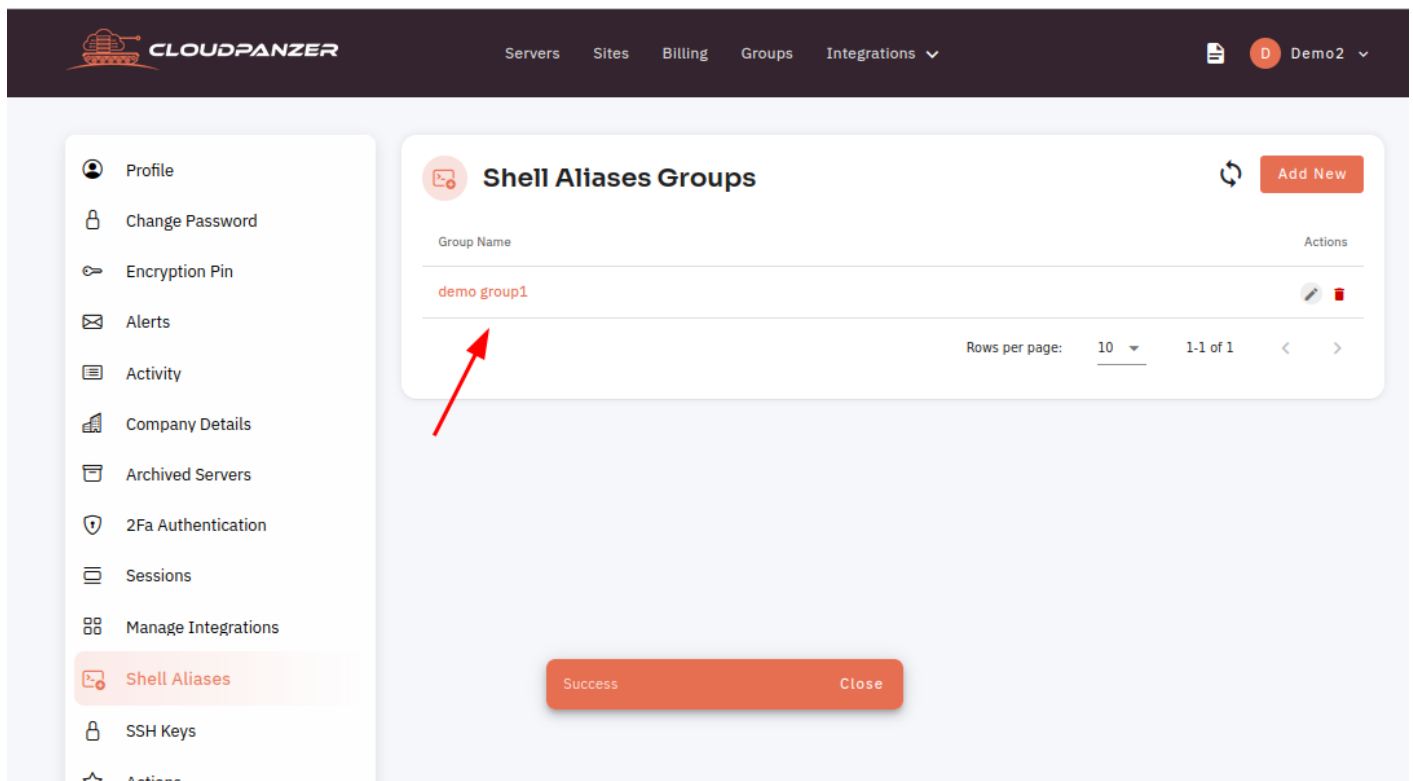
4. Click on the Edit icon.
