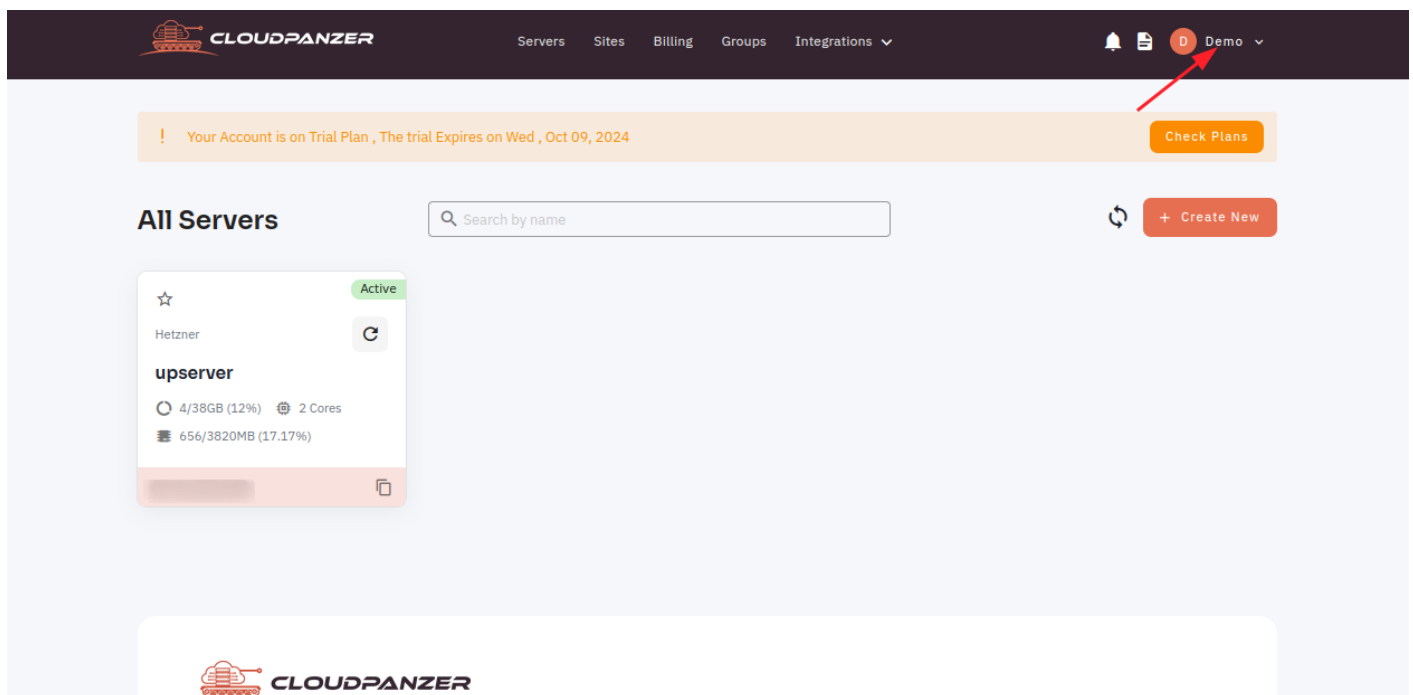

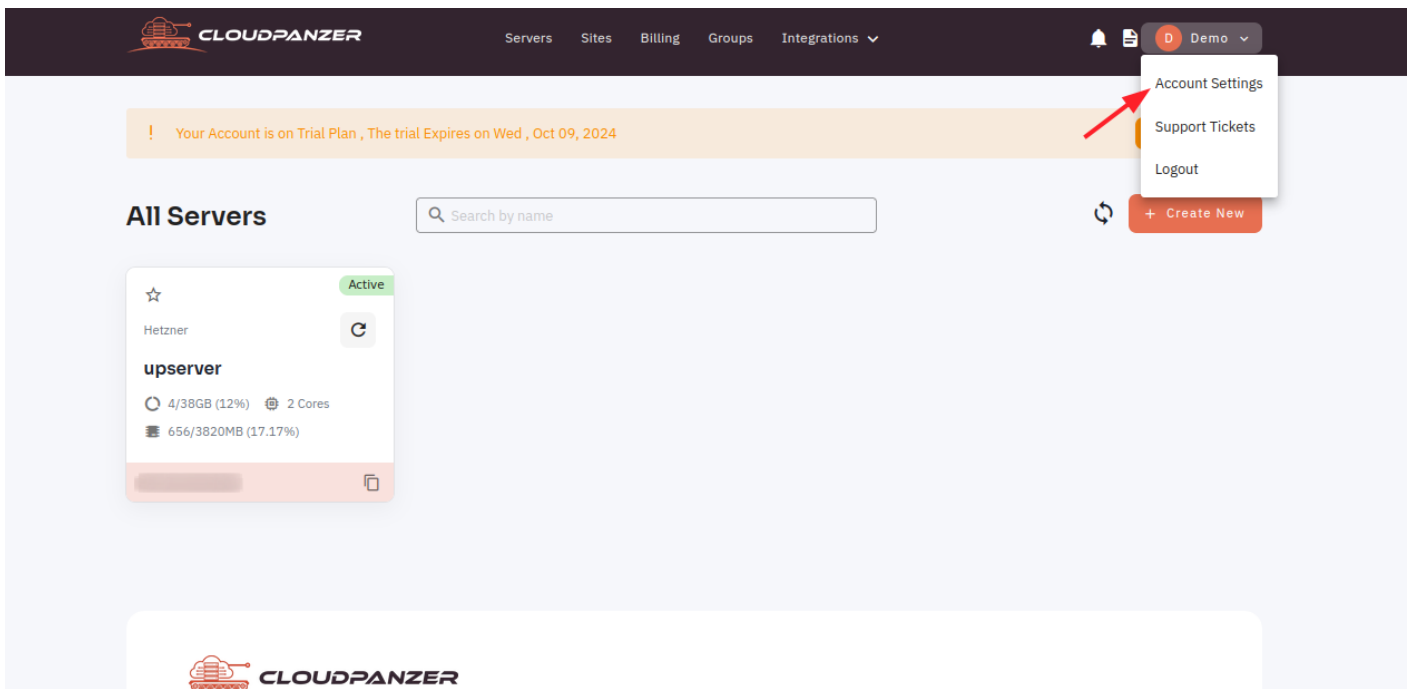

Follow the steps below to edit the User SSH Key

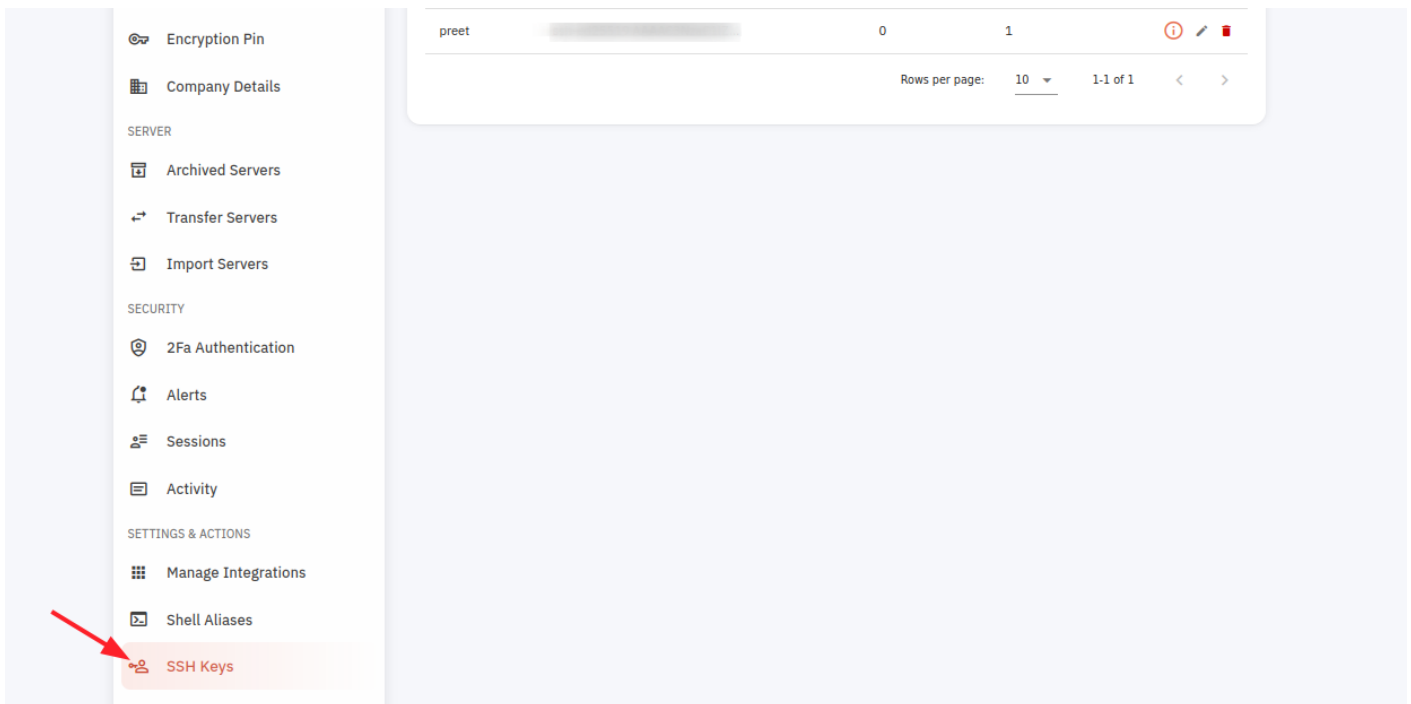
1. Click on the user profile.



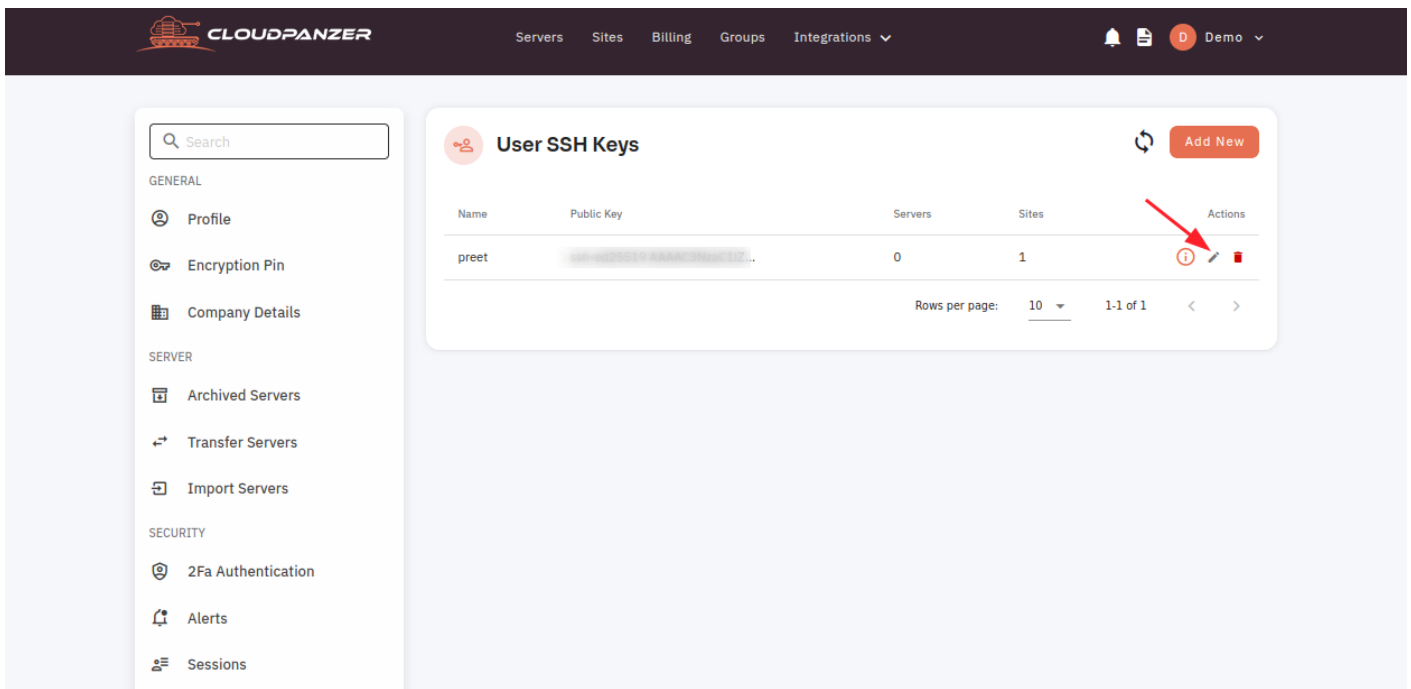
2. Click on the Account Settings option.



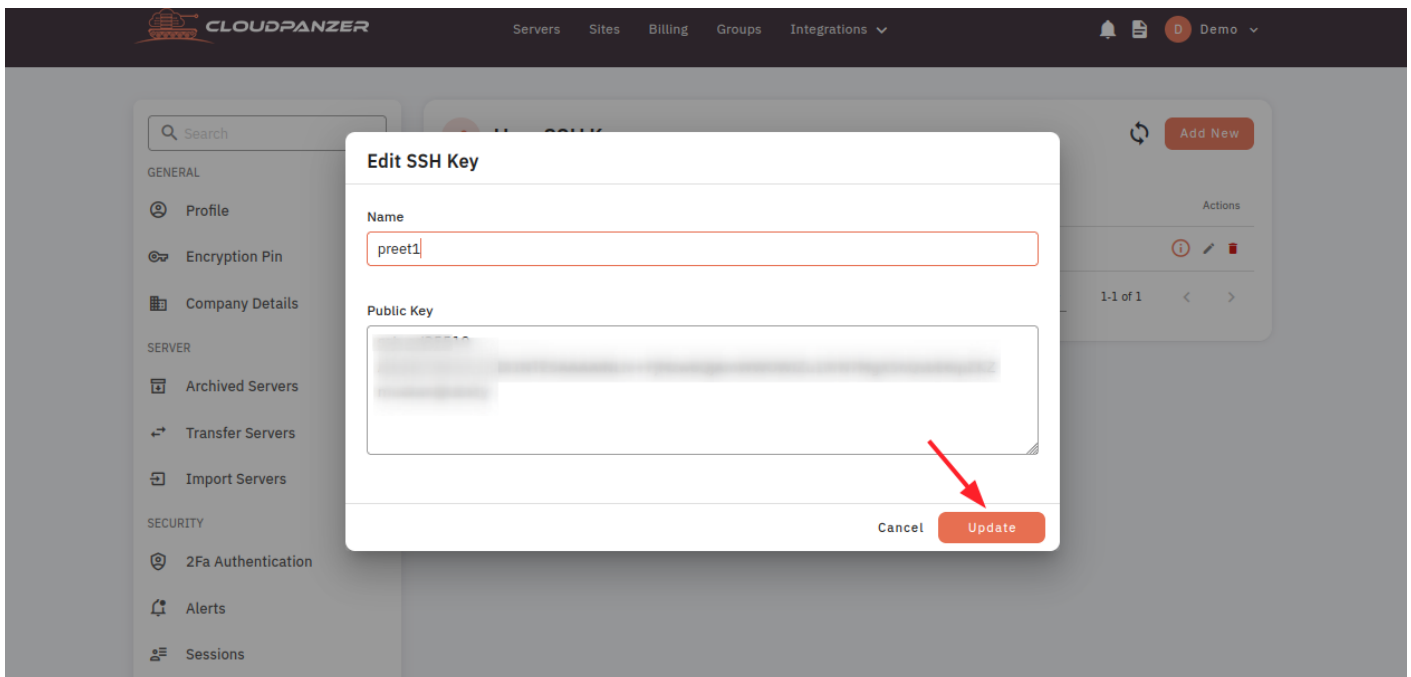
3. Click on the SSH Keys option.
