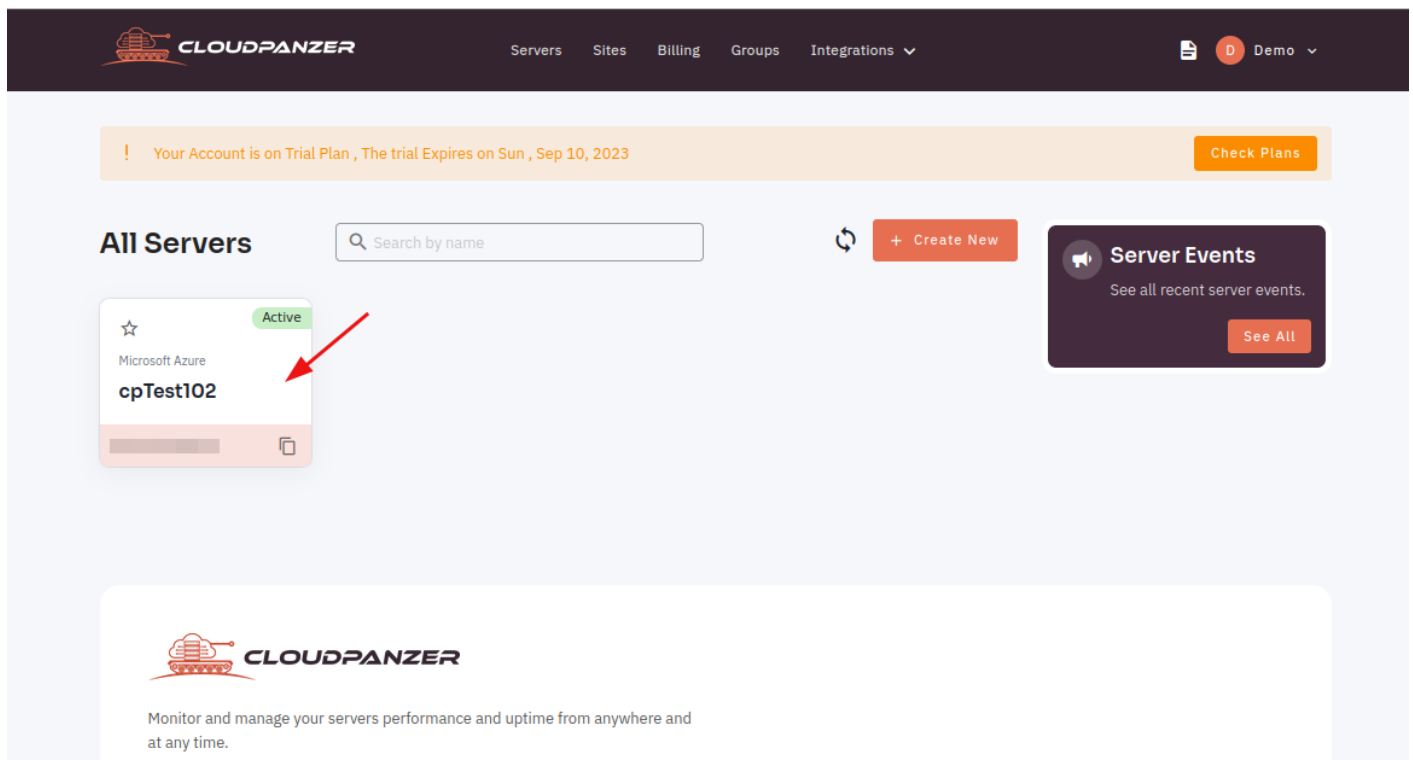


# How to enable/disable Server Protection through the Cloudpanzer website?

Follow the steps below to enable/disable Server Protection.

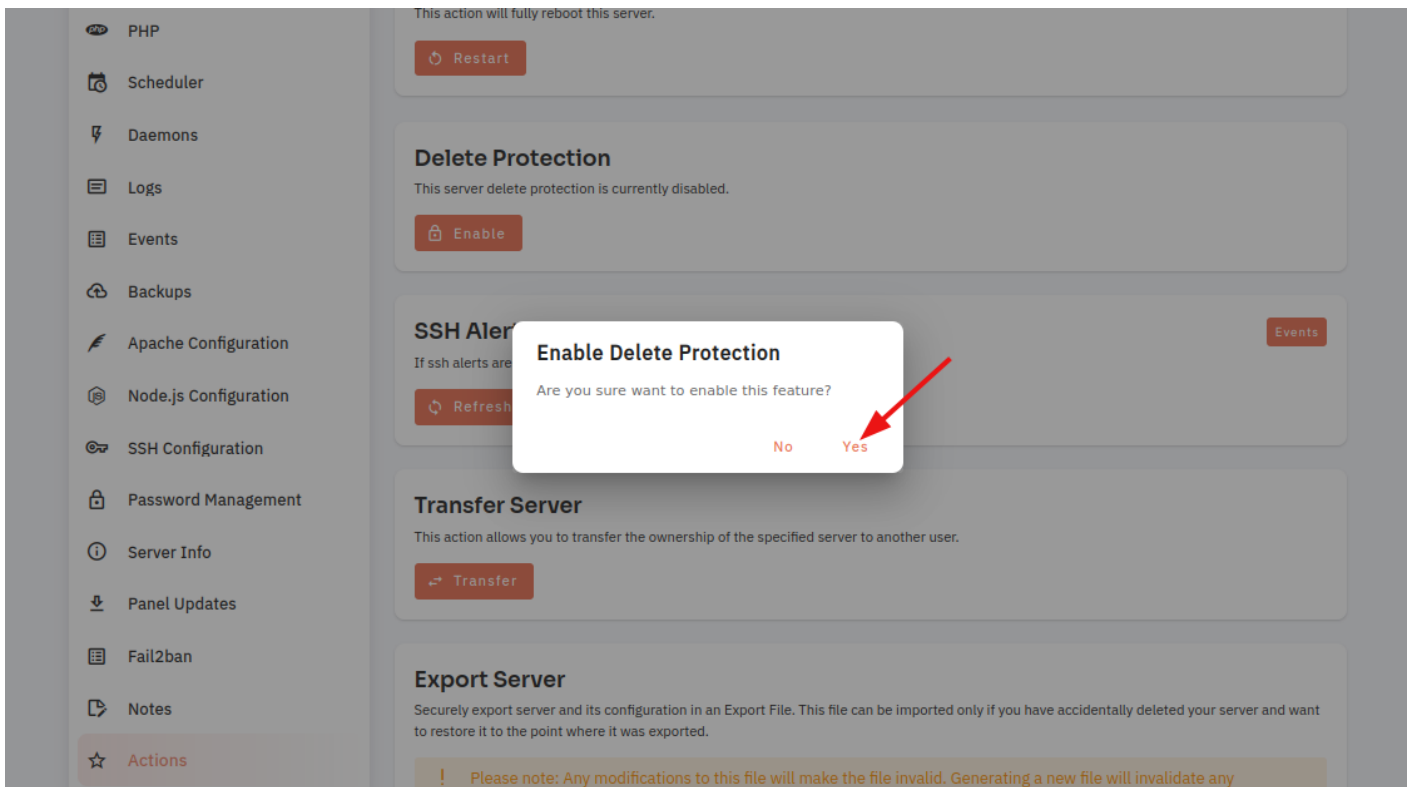

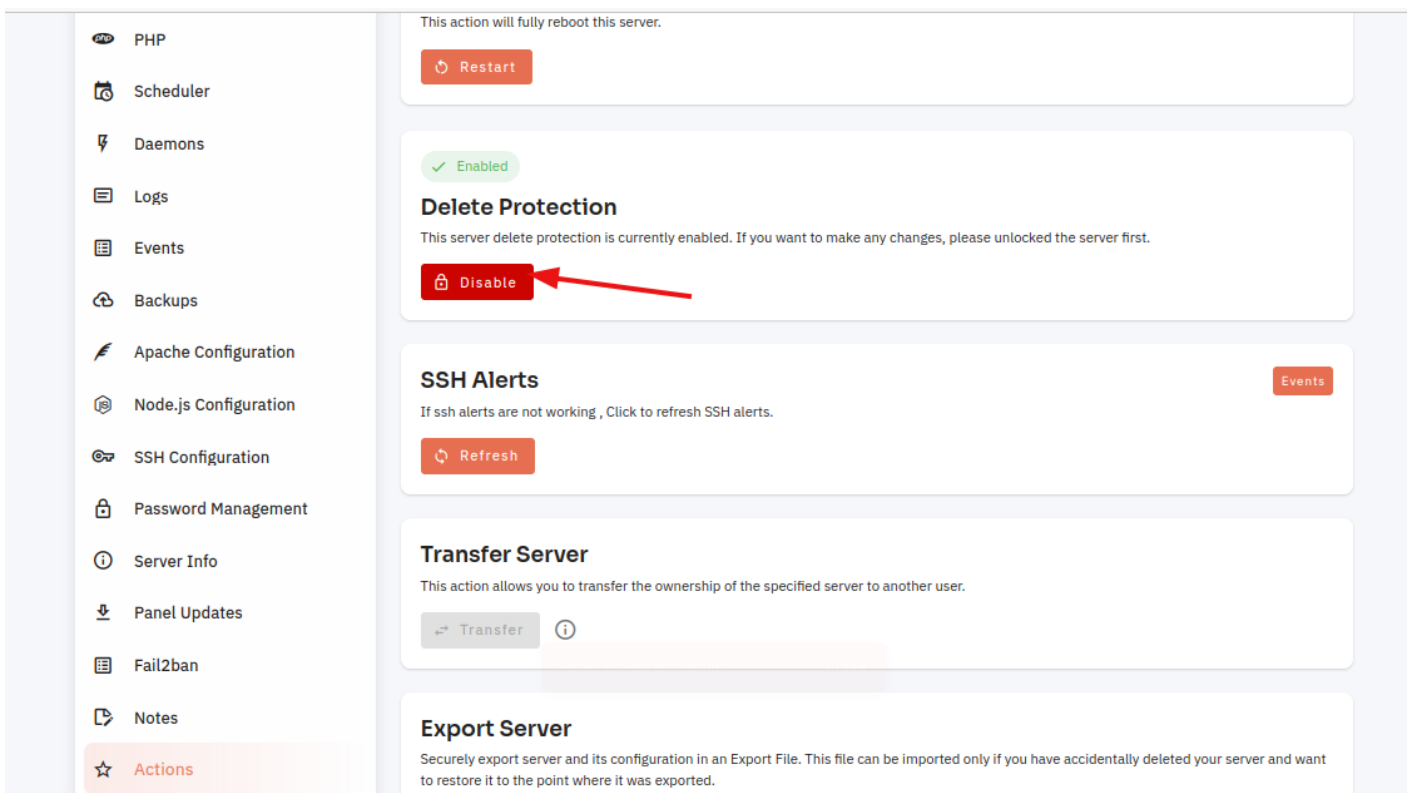
3. Click on the enable Button.

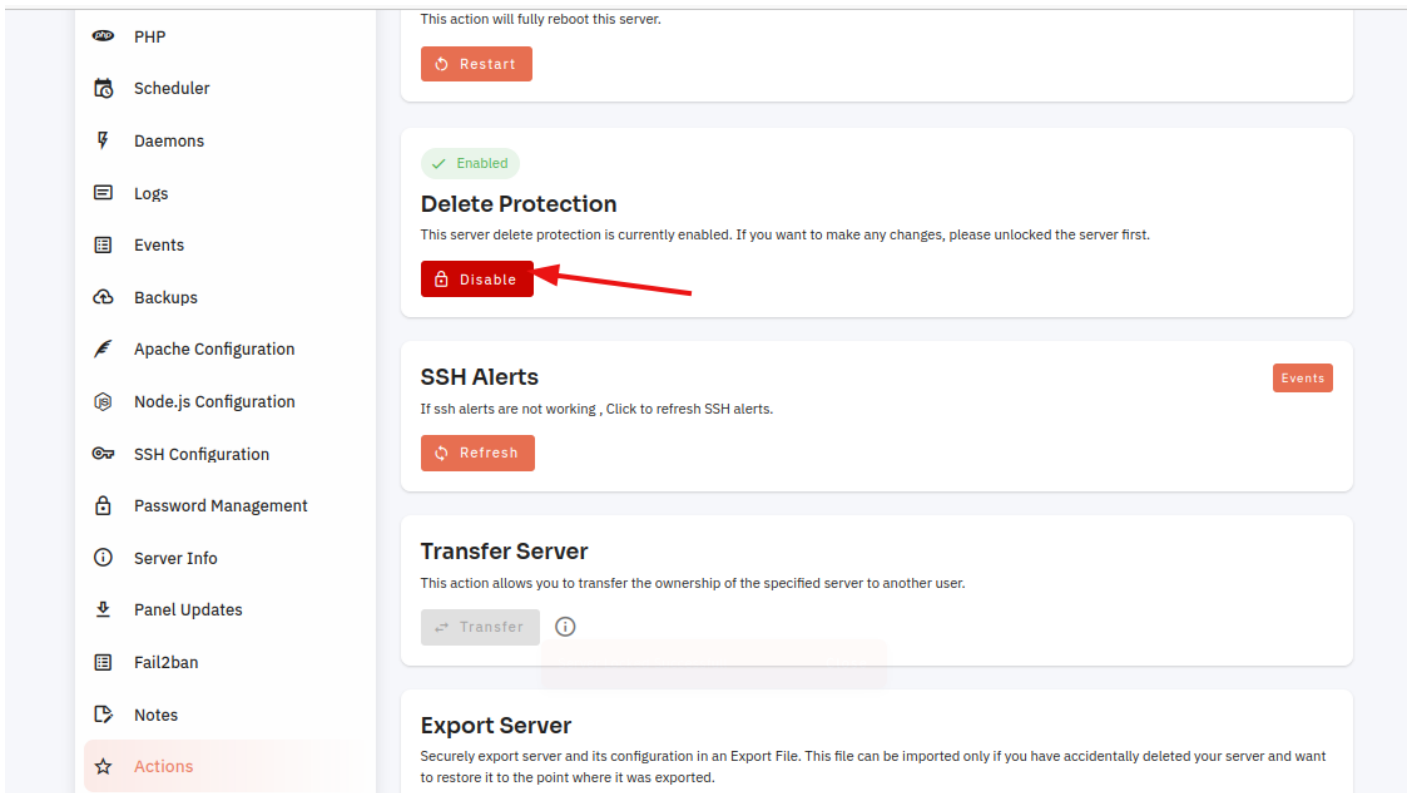

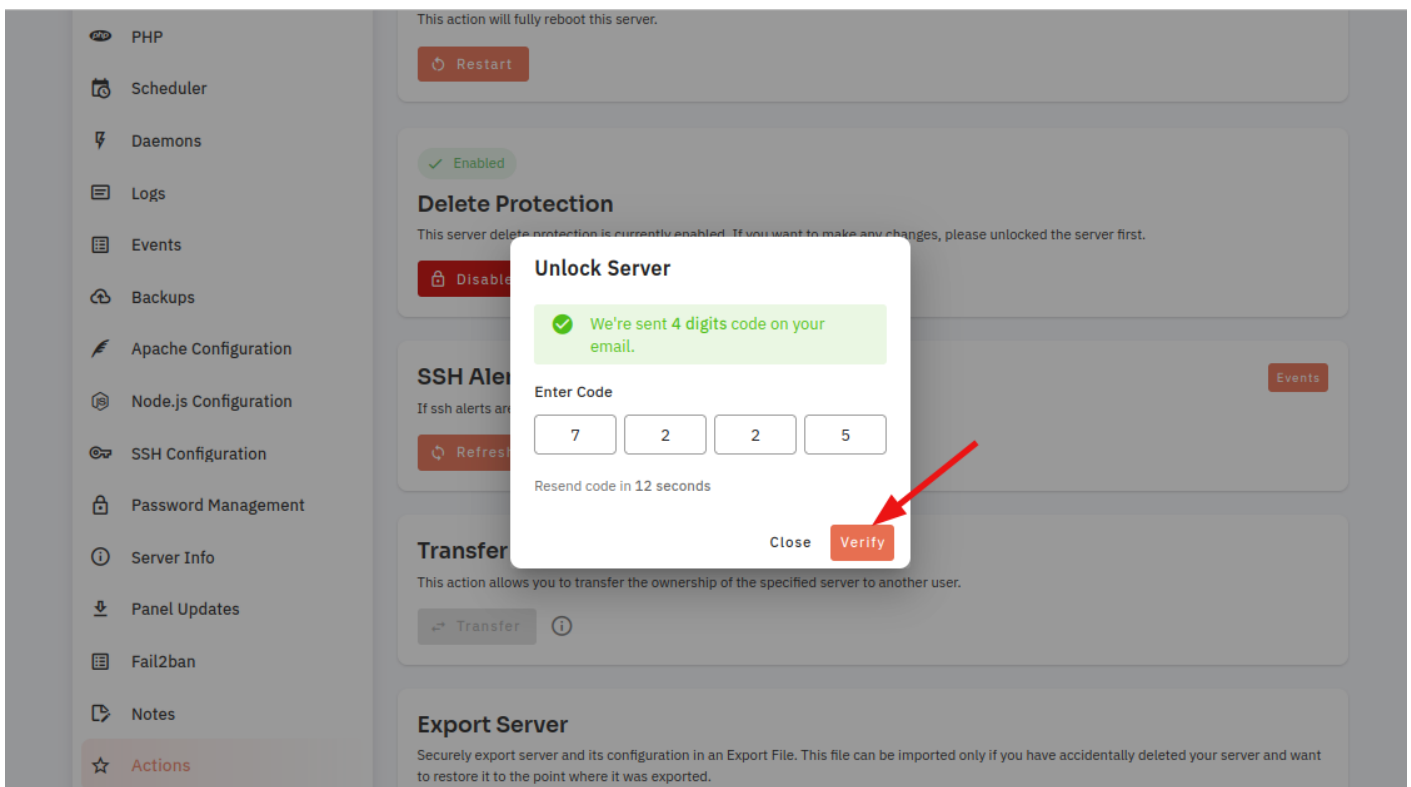

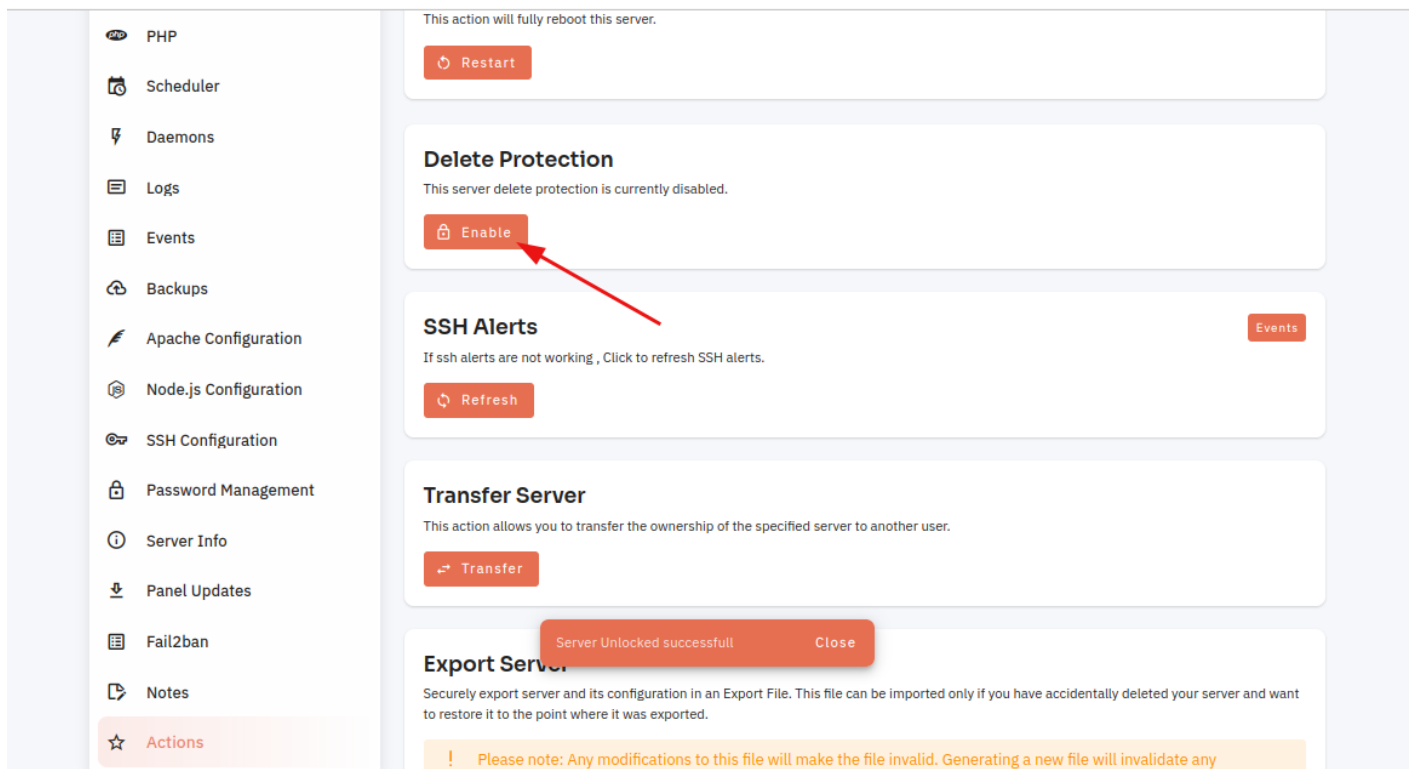
5. Click On the disable Button.
