PhpMyAdmin is a free and open-source web-based database management tool written in PHP. It is designed to allow users to manage their databases through a web browser easily. With phpMyAdmin, users can create, modify, and delete databases, tables, and table fields, execute SQL statements and manage users and privileges.





3. Select site.




4. Select the App Option.


5. Click on the PhpMyAdmin card.




6. Click on the drop-down.
