


How to Navigate Network Settings?

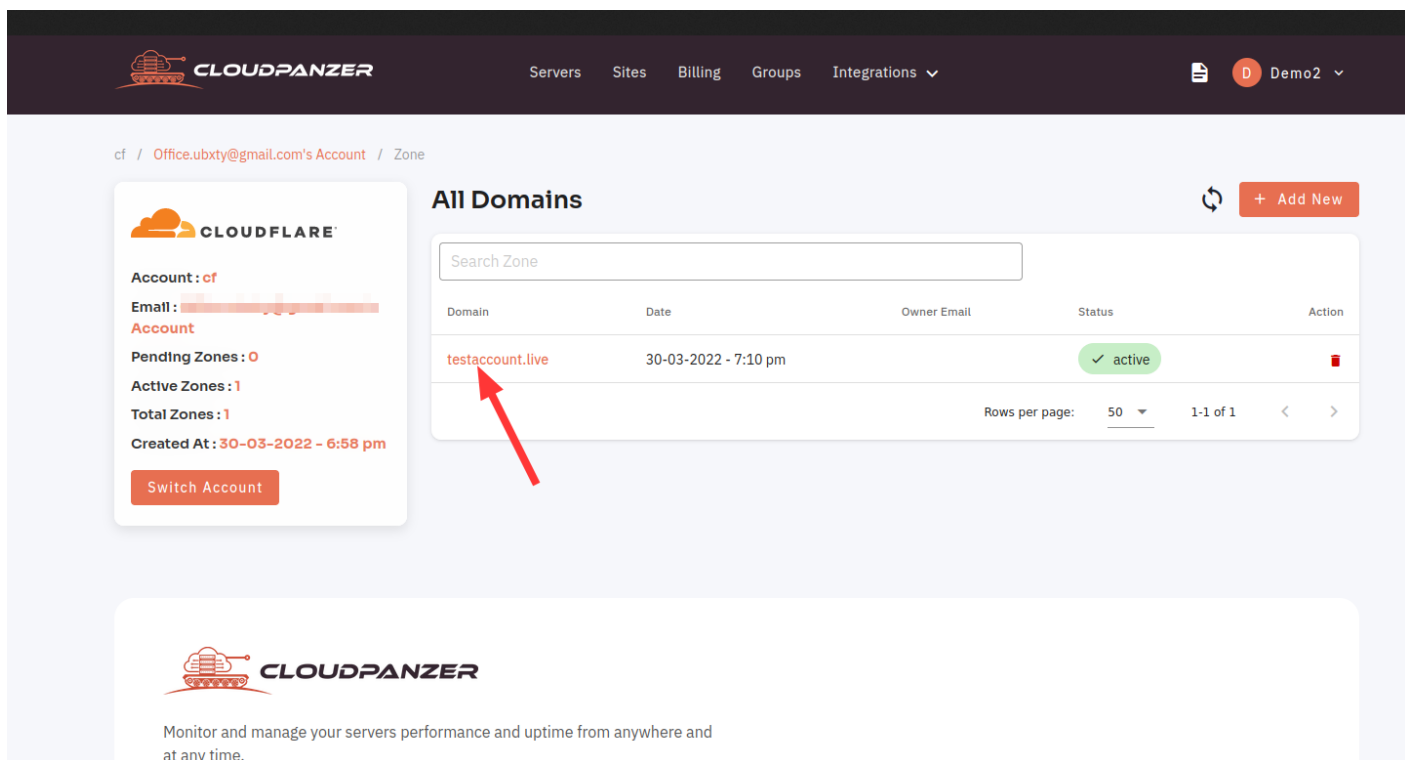
1. Select your account.



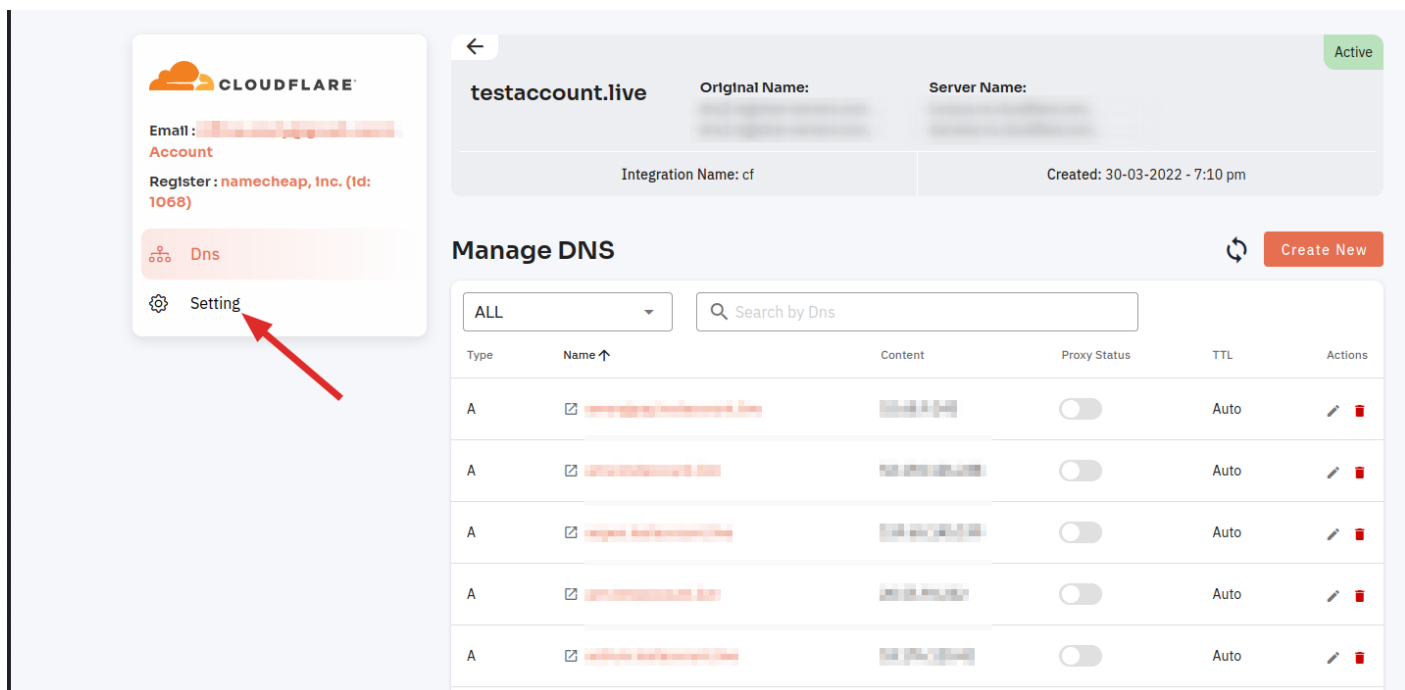

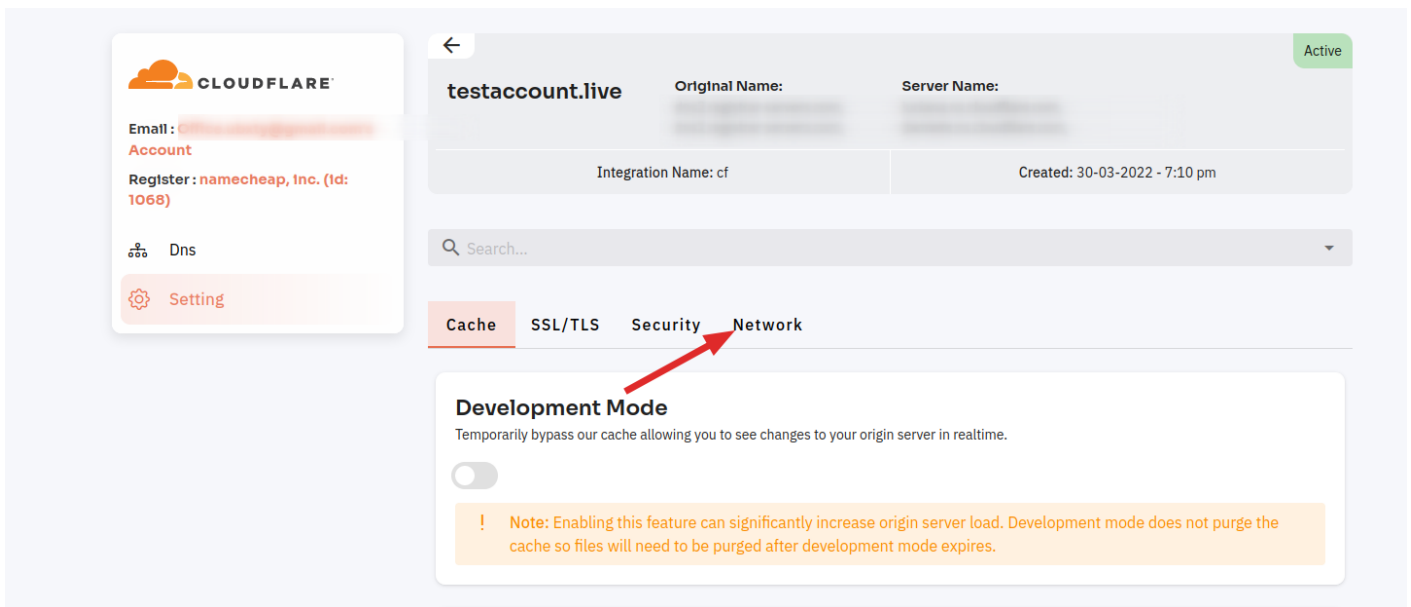
2. Click on the Domain.



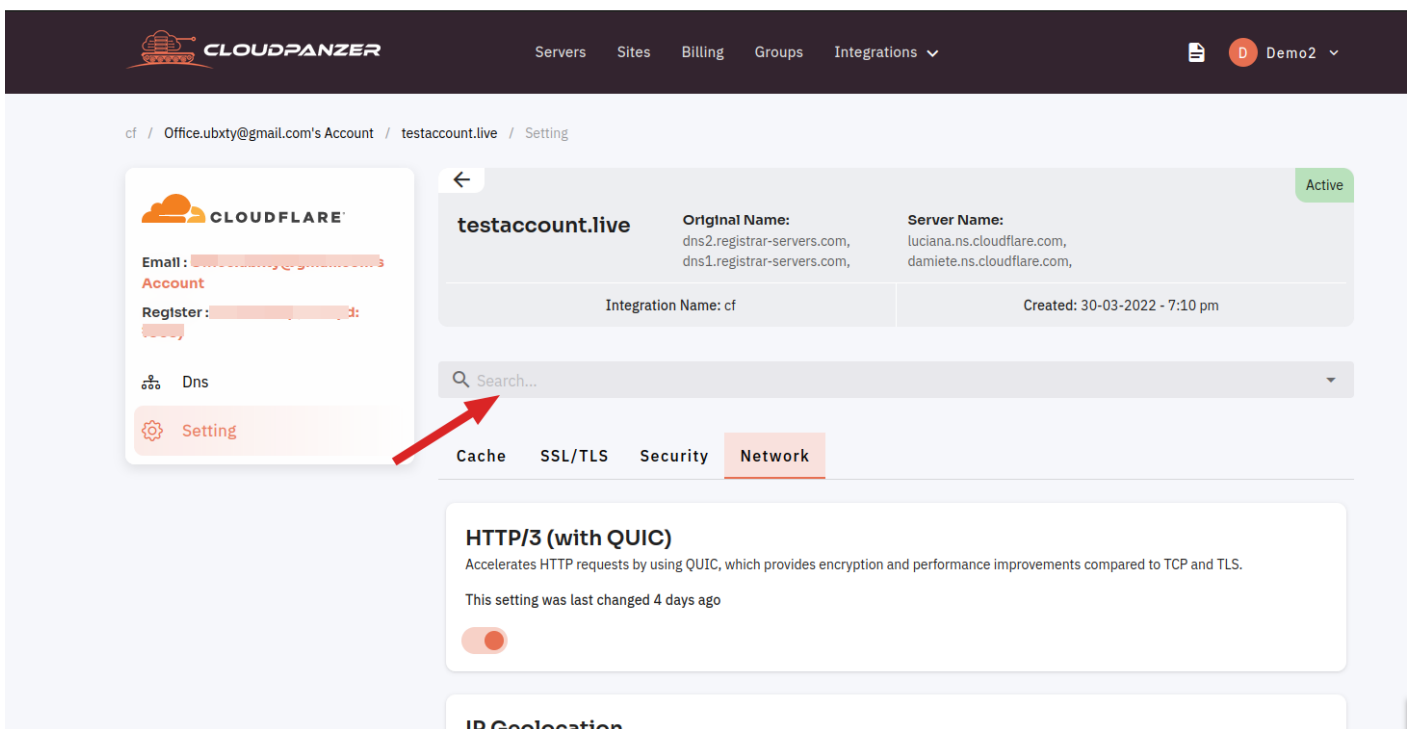
3. Click on the "**Setting**" button.



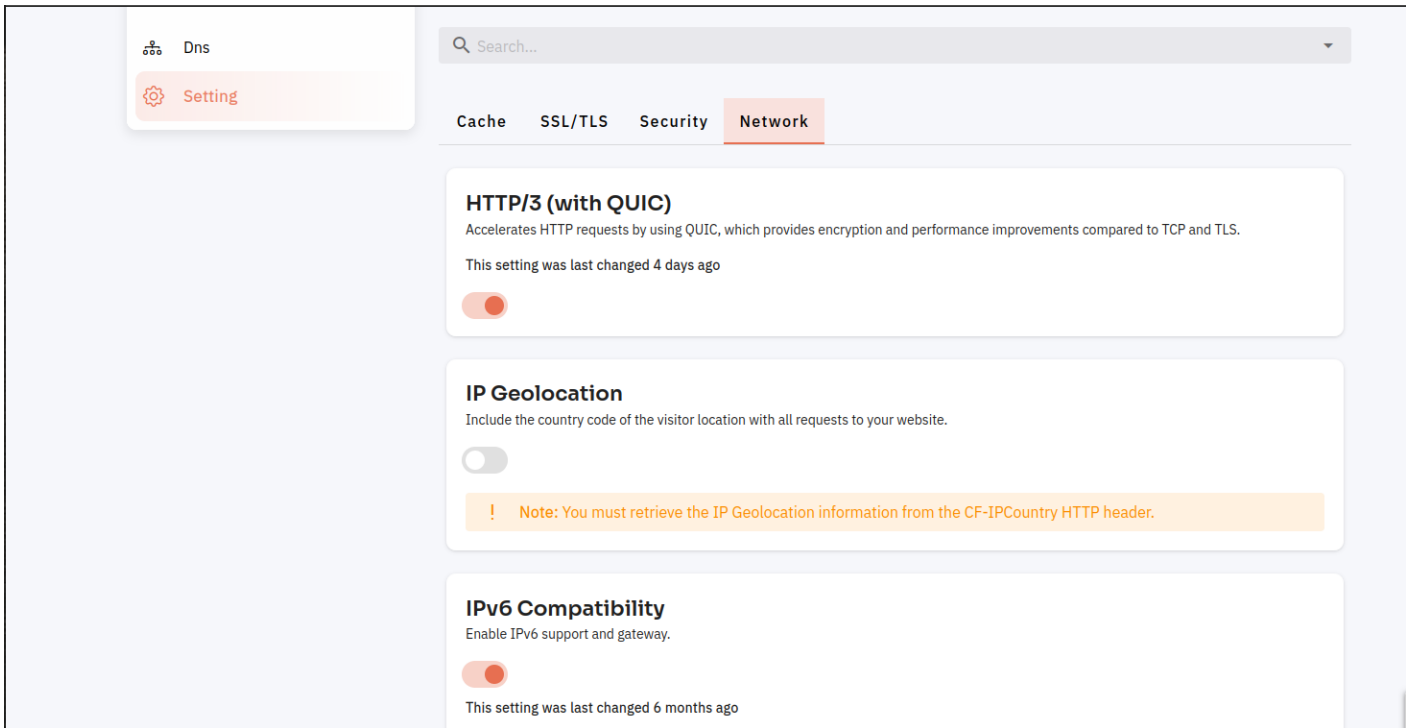
4. Click on the "**Network**" Tab.
