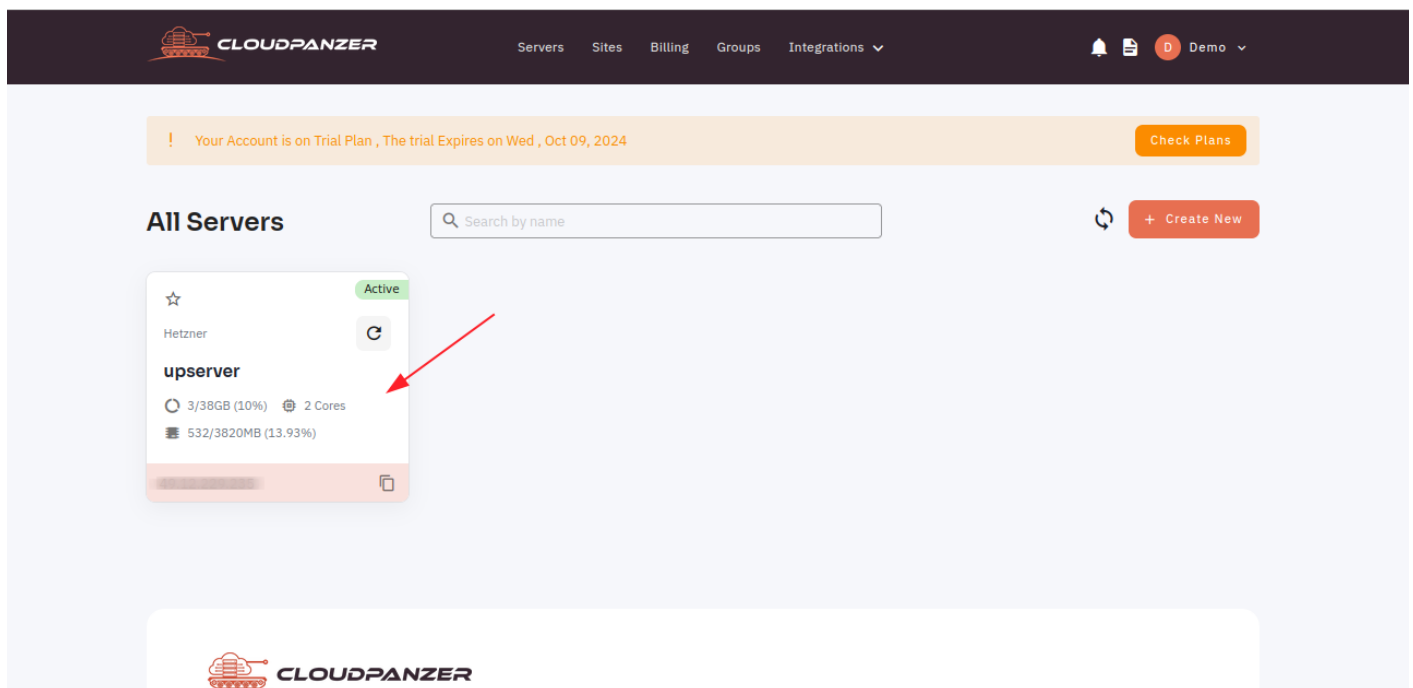


How to Navigate Run Command ?
