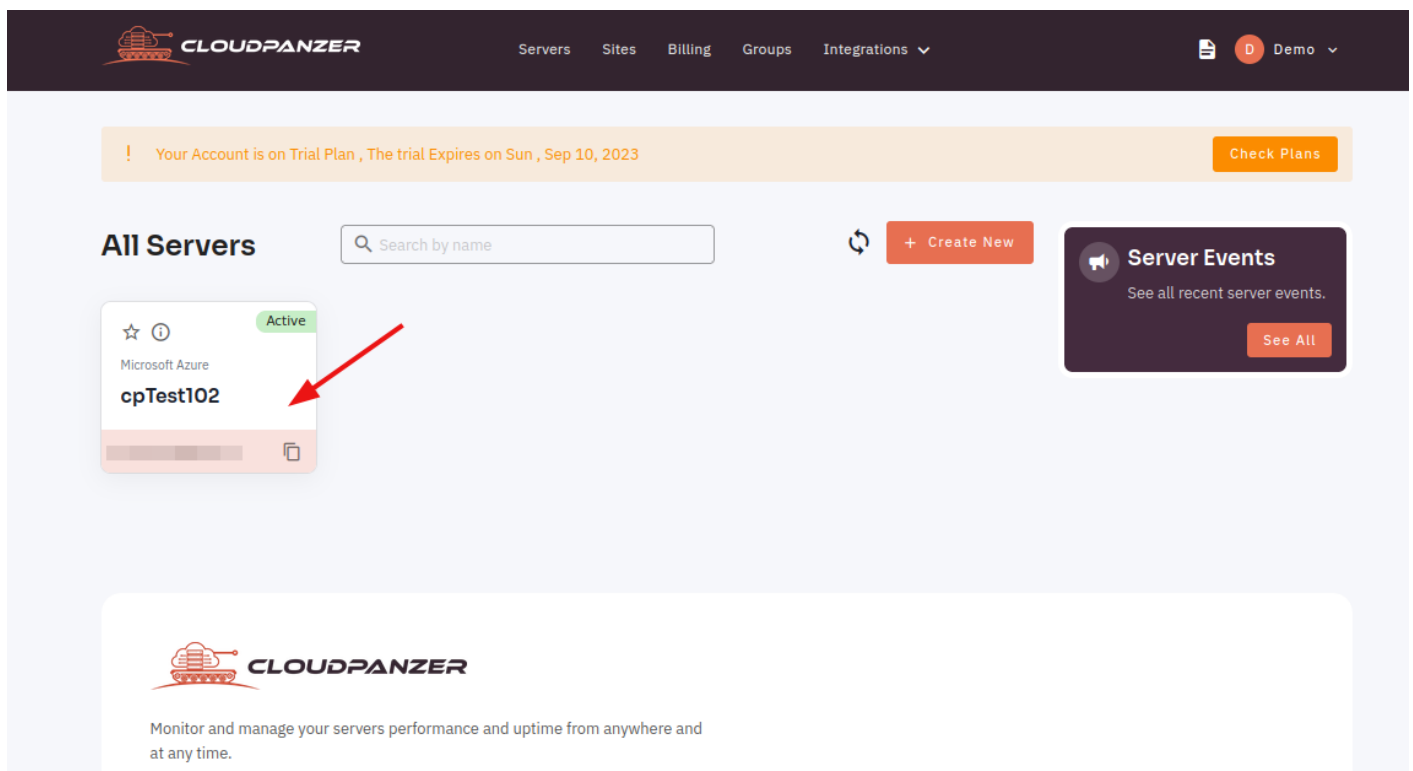


# How to Navigate Site Meta through the Cloudpanzer website?
